- HO1 Vase of six Sweet Peas
- HO2 One Hosta leaf
- HO3 Three stems of Rose - any variety
- HO4 One succulent plant
- HO5 Vase of fresh flowers
- HO6 One Cactus - 8-inch pot maximum
- HO7 One Hybrid Tea Rose
- HO8 One pot plant - foliage only
- HO9 One pot plant – flowering
- HO10 One Begonia plant - 8-inch pot maximum
- HO11 One Geranium plant - 8-inch pot maximum

The competitor gaining the most points in this section HO1 – HO11 will be awarded The William Foxton Rosebowl. The winner of HO1 will be awarded The Runcie Cup for the Best Sweet Peas

SECTION THREE (All exhibits must have been grown by the exhibitor, only 1 entry per class)

- HO12 Three coloured potatoes - one variety
- HO13 Four red tomatoes
- HO14 Three onions grown from sets – dressed
- HO15 Two round beetroot - tops trimmed to 3 inches maximum
- HO16 Three white potatoes - one variety
- HO17 Five pods of peas
- HO18 Four pods of broad beans
- HO19 Three onions grown from seed - washed but not dressed
- HO20 Two carrots - tops trimmed to 3 inches maximum

- HO21 One green cabbage - with a 2-inch stalk
- HO22 Tray of four kinds of vegetables - one each variety
- HO23 Five shallots – dressed
- HO24 One cucumber
- HO25 Two courgettes, any colour - maximum 7 inches
- HO26 One marrow - maximum 14 inches
- HO27 One flower and one vegetable
