- ☐ **Art in the Park:** an art festival right in downtown Petoskey will be happening on Saturday, July 18 of our wedding weekend! Each year over 100 artists' booths are set up in Pennsylvania Park in downtown Petoskey (walking distance from the Perry Hotel).
- ☐ **Beard's Brewery:** Large space with outdoor patio overlooking the water with beer, wine and cocktails
- ☐ **Chandler's:** Upscale restaurant, great option for brunch or dinner
- ☐ **Clty Park Grill:** Historic pub constructed in 1875. Fun fact: Ernest Hemingway used to sit at the bar and write!
- ☐ **Bay Front Park:** 25-acre waterfront park accessible from downtown Petoskey via tunnel
