

Programs Approved in Other States

The following programs are offered primarily online with some face-to-face requirements. Please know that PELSB is unable to pre-approve any licensure program located outside of Minnesota. Enrolling in an out-of-state program does not guarantee licensure in Minnesota. Prior to enrolling in a program in another state, you will want to verify that all of the following are true:

- The program is approved and will lead to licensure in another state. A good way to verify this is to ask if the program will be able to recommend you for licensure at the end of the program.
- There is either the field-specific student teaching that is the equivalent of what would be required in a Minnesota program or that you teach two years as the teacher of record aligned to that licensure area.
- Whether the program is 100% online or if there are any requirements to be on-campus.
- If you do not yet hold a bachelor's degree from a college in the US that is regionally accredited by the Higher Learning Commission (HLC), or the regional association for accreditation of colleges and secondary schools, or hold a credential from outside of the US that is found to be the equivalent to a bachelor's degree by NACES, that you would earn a degree that would be regionally accredited by the HLC or the regional association for accreditation of colleges and secondary schools.
- That you do not have a <u>criminal conviction</u> that will prevent you from being licensed.
