







PLANNING "HOT TIPS"

- 1. How to get free credits on Teachers Pay Teachers:
 - a. If you write a review for things you bought, they give you credits in your account toward future purchases.
- 2. Google Meet now has breakout rooms!
 - a. <u>Download the extension and watch the Video</u> (more detailed instructions long version)
 - b. You can use <u>Google slides</u> during Breakout rooms and have groups edit a slide, then share out upon return to the whole class
- 3. Did you know that you can create a self-grading quiz in Skyward?
 - a. This means you don't need to transfer grades!
 - b. Be sure to make an announcement in Google Classroom that they need to log into Skyward for the quiz
- 4. When making an assignment in Classroom, don't forget to set the actual point value that you will use in Skyward.
 - a. Some parents are confused by assignments being worth 100 points in Classroom but only 20 points in Skyward
- 5. Introducing Google Assignments! Video link
 - a. This includes originality reports (aka did the student copy and paste their answers?)
- 6. Making images into links in Seesaw
