What do you know about voting?

What does it mean to be a good citizen?

What is good about America, what is there about this country to be proud of?

What do you wish were different about our country or our world?

What do you want to be when you grow up?

If you had a superpower, what would you want to be able to do and what would you do first?

What good things do you think might happen in the future, and what do you think we should do to try to make it happen?

What bad thing do you think might happen in the future and what do you think we should do about it, to try to make it not happen?

Do you pay any attention to the news, to what's happening in the world?

Do you think kids should take a more active role in deciding what we should do?

Who are your heroes?

What would you want to make happen, if you were old enough to vote?

What age do you think people should be to be able to vote?

Do you think kids have good ideas? What do you think your best idea is?

How do you get your news, how do you know what's happening in the world?
