Westminster Larger Catechism

Q. 72. What is justifying faith?

A. Justifying faith is a saving gracel that works in the hearts of sinners by the Spirit2 and the word of God.3 By it sinners are convinced of their sinfulness and miserable condition and realize that neither they nor anyone or anything else can get them out of that lost condition,4 and by it they give full assent to the truth of the gospel promise;5 they receive and rest on Christ and his righteousness for pardon from sin,6 as the gospel tells us, and for being accepted and accounted as righteous in the sight of God for salvation.7 1.Heb 10.39. 2.2 Cor 4.13, Eph 1.17-19. 3.Rom 10.14,17, 2 Thes 2.13. 4.Acts 2.37, 16.30, Jn 16.8-9, Rom 6.6, 7.9, Eph 2.1, Acts 4.12. 5.Eph 1.13, Rom 10.8-10. 6.Jn 1.12, Acts 16.31, 10.43, Gal 2.15-16. 7.Phil 3.9, Acts 15.11.

Q. 73. How does faith justify a sinner in the sight of God?

A. Faith justifies a sinner in the sight of God only as a tool by which the sinner receives Christ and puts Christ's righteousness into effect,1 not because of any other grace that accompanies faith and not because of any good works that result from faith.2 Nor is it the case that the grace of faith or any action springing from it is imputed to the sinner for his justification.3
