



PROGRAM OVERVIEW

What To Bring

Snowboard With Leash, Board/Ski Boots, Skis With Brakes, Poles, Helmet.

Participants/Parents Are Responsible For Ensuring That Their Equipment Is In Good Working Condition And Includes The Appropriate Safety Equipment (Brakes For Skis, Leashes For Boards). This Includes Weekly Checks On Binding Screws.

Participants Are Responsible For Their Own Equipment And Should Know Where Their Equipment Is At All Times. Locking Equipment Is Strongly Encouraged, As Well As Keeping The Serial # Written Down At Home.

Helmet; Good-Quality Skiing/Boarding Gloves Or Mittens - Waterproof And Rated For Cold Weather (extra Pair In Backpack Recommended); Goggles (Essential In All Weather Conditions); Neck Warmer; Extra Socks; Sun Block; Watch; Lunch, Drink, & Snack, Or Money To Purchase Food; A Backpack To Carry Lunch And Other Items. Pay Lockers Are Available In The Upper Mountain Lodge Only. Keep In Mind That It Gets Pretty Cold On The Mountain. Make Sure You Dress Accordingly. It Is Best To Dress In Layers.

Morning Drop Off @ MES

Arrive At MES On Herrick Avenue Between 7:00 A.M. and 7:15 A.M. To Load Equipment & Bus. The Bus Will Leave At 7:30 A.M. Sharp. All Trucks Will Be Loaded By An Adult.... Participants Must Not Load Any Equipment Onto Any Truck.

Check-In Is Required When Boarding The Bus And Participants Are Not Permitted To Leave The Bus Until It Reaches Its Final Destination (Smuggs' Or MES). Keep Buses Clean And Damage Free.

Alternative Transportation Policy

All Participants Are Encouraged To Ride To & From The Mountain On The Bus. If Alternative Transportation Is To Be Used Then Written Consent Must Be Provided By A Parent Or Guardian Stating Who Will Be Providing The Transportation. This must be received by 9:00 pm the Friday night before the ski/board day via email or text.

*******Only Email, Text & Hand Written Consent Is Permitted!*******

And Must Be Provided For Each Instance The Participant Will Not Be Using Bus Transportation A Blanket Note Is Allowable If Your Child Will Be Riding With The Same Person For The Season. Written Notes Are To Be Given Directly To Melinda @ The Bus Window By Participant And/Or Parent And Participant.

When At Smugglers Notch

Know Your Bus Location In Parking Lot. Please Note That Going Back To The Bus During The Day Is Prohibited.

The Participant Is Responsible For Transporting Their Equipment And Any Other Gear From The Bus Once it Has Arrived And Parked In Its Designated Area. Please Limit Gear To Fit In Only 1 Backpack Or Duffel Bag.

Know Your Chaperone's Names, As Well As Where And What Time You Are Meeting.

Every Participant Must Ski/Ride With A Buddy And Stay Within Resort Boundaries. If A Participant's Buddy Is Injured He/She Must Stay With That Buddy While They Are Transported To Ski Patrol.

Participants Are Expected To Adhere To All Smugglers' Notch Ski Area Rules And To Behave Appropriately At All Times. This Includes Staying Within Boundaries (the "back Bowls" Are Out Of Bounds) And Skiing/Riding Only On Open Trails.

The Fun Zone & Swimming Pool Are Off Limits To Club Members.

Participants Using Hand-Held 2-Way Radios Should Not Use A Club Channel (21.2).

Smuggs' End Of Day & Pick Up @ MES

Participants Must Be On The Bus No Later Than 4:00 P.M.. Plan Any Last Runs With Plenty Of Time To Get To The Bus.

The Buses Will Not Depart Smuggs' Until All Members Are Accounted For, So Please Be On Time!

The Bus, Participant Of The Club And All Gear Will Arrive Back At Herrick Avenue Around 4:30 - 4:45

P.M.

Please Be On Time To Pick Up Your Child/Children. We Will Always Have At Least One Chaperone Or Volunteer Stay Until The Last Participant Has Left The Premises.

Disciplinary Policy

Instruction will be provided to beginner snowboarders and skiers only. We will offer an Upper Mountain Instruction this year to get to know the mountain.

MSRC chaperones will be available on the mountain and in the lodge to assist participants throughout the day.
