

How to access the sandbox server

Jeff and Aaron are managing our server again for EVOMC17. To get there:


- 1. Run Minecraft and select "Multiplayer"
- 2. Click "Add Server"
- 3. In "Server Address" type in the IP address of our server and then select "Done". We will provide this address once the session has started
- 4. From here click on the server that pops up and then click the button "Join Server".

You'll need to set your user profile to version 1.10.2 see http://missions4evomc.pbworks.com/Server_Info for more info

Participants will be whitelisted on the server according to the names they provide on the enrollment form for the course http://tinyurl.com/evomc17-register. If you don't provide a Minecraft username when you fill in the Google form, or have left out any other information, you should be able to edit your form, or you can provide it to us, later. Or simply fill out a new form and we'll remove the previous record from our dbase.



Week 4- Cluster - Jan 30 - Feb 5

Week 4 - Cluster behavior typically sets in at MOOCs where participants form groups around shared interests. Our server can be a slightly daunting place to enter for the first time, but our moderators will have set up some safe houses marked by signs or perhaps even beacons of light where noobs can survive to dawn and gather materials in daylight and get back inside (and shut the door) at night.

Week 5 - Focus on aspects of Minecraft you are interested in. - 2. AFTER THAT you visit http://tinyurl.com/evomc17-badgetrack and ask to JOIN the sheet for editing access (you will have to have a Google acct in order to that that. If you have enrolled (Step 1) your request will be granted.
- 3. As you accomplish your missions, fill in details with links or dates of your evidence.

If you earn a badge, it will be sent to the gmail address you provide when you requested access to this document http://tinyurl.com/evomc17-badgetrack. If you want it sent to some other address write vancestev@gmail.com and inform Vance of the address you'd like used.

NOTE March was the last month that session facilitators were checking to see who had earned a badge in 2016. Editing rights were then removed in order to lock down the evidence document for viewing only. However, if you wish to add evidence after that you can request to join the document. This will alert Vance that someone wishes to provide

evidence, and once you have done that, if you then qualify, you will be issued your badge. The time limit on that is the start of the next EVOMC session.

Vance will create a new Survivor's Badge for EVOMC17. This will be done prior to the end of the EVO session (by this I mean that the artwork and badge itself must be different from the previous ones, whose criteria specified 2015 and 2016, and whose evidence pointed to Google sheets for those years)
