**CORE INTERNALS**

Internal Compartments are module slots reserved for all other ship functions. They are divided into two types: Core Internals, which encompasses basic functions, and Optional Internals, which can expand the breadth of the ship's capabilities. A ship cannot operate without an appropriate module in each Core Internal slot, while Optional Internals can be left entirely empty if desired. Some Optional Internal compartments are restricted, and can only hold specific types of optional modules.

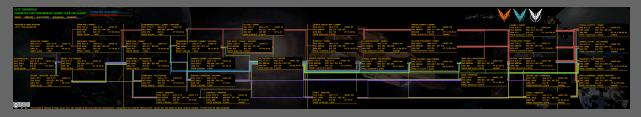

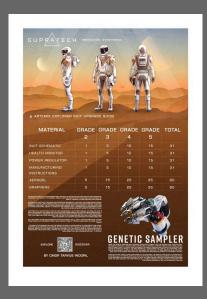

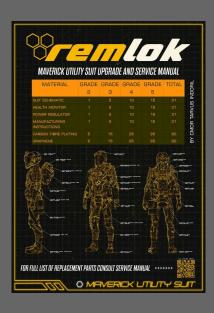
### **Odyssey Content**

The landmark feature of *Odyssey* is the addition of the ability to explore planets on foot. This is permitted not only on all non-atmospheric landable planets, but *Odyssey* also opens planets with tenuous or thin atmospheres for landings for the first time, increasing the number of available landable bodies in the game by over 20%.

Landing on planets with tenuous atmospheres requires the new Advanced Planetary
Approach Suite module. On Foot activities require a suit to protect the player from the
hostile environment, but some planets are so inhospitable that players cannot
disembark from their ships even if their ships are able to land. In order to disembark
from a ship on foot, the player must first land the ship on the ground. A planet's gravity
is also a factor during On Foot activities, and can affect the player's movement, jumping,
and their thrown grenades.

### **Fleet Carriers**



The Drake-Class Carrier, also known as the Fleet Carrier, is a Capital Ship manufactured by Brewer Corporation. It is the largest and most expensive vessel available to independent pilots for purchase. It features a total of 16 Landing Pads to accommodate other conventional ships, and is jump-capable, allowing it to act as a mobile base with much of the functionality and services of a typical station.

The vessels also have a total cargo capacity of 25,000 t, which is used both to store commodities and hold the infrastructure necessary for various optional services, a total fuel capacity of 1,000 t of Tritium, and 20 defence turret emplacements.

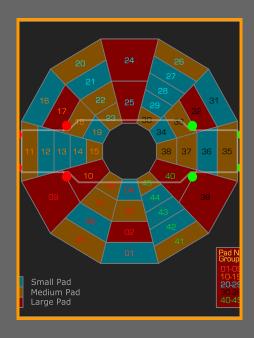
#### **Tips for Commanding Carriers**

- Placing Tritium in commodity storage works as reserve tank
- Up to 16 Fleet Carriers may orbit a given star, planet, or moon
- Like Stations, Fleet Carriers are indestructible and possess defensive capabilities in order to defend themselves and nearby non-hostile ships from attackers

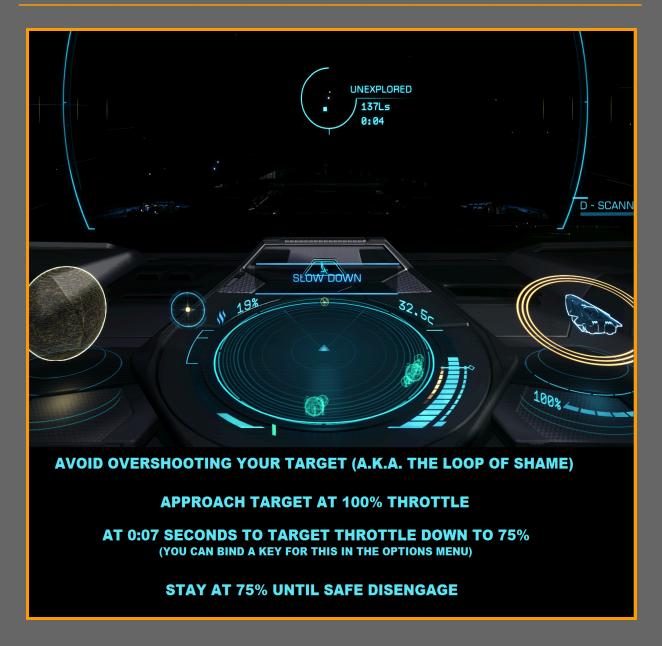
### When Docking/Departing make sure to follow the Green Lights or Try to at least...



Rule # 1 Always Fly with a Rebuy

- The docking port on a Coriolis Station is always positioned on the 'end' that is spinning counter-clockwise. Looking for advertising holograms often helps. The side of the station opposite of the side with the entry port will also have red lights in the corners that flash periodically.
- The ship's compass (to the left of the scanner) points towards the docking pad currently allocated to your ship. The indicator will be an outline if the target is behind you.
- When landing, you can't see the landing pad, because it has to be below your ship. However, while approaching the landing pad, you can fly on the back or head straight for the pad, so you can keep the pad in sight. You can then rotate when you are close enough.
- Enabling the landing gear decreases your velocity. To speedup landing, you can keep it disabled until you are directly over the pad. However, enabling the landing gear will also make your ship more maneuverable at lower speed.

### **Navigation Tips**



A.K.A. "The Loop of Shame". Your speed will still be affected by the mass of nearby planets but you can safely ignore any slow down warnings.

### « Remember This! »

These are the types of Stars that a Cmdr can get Fuel off of by Scooping the Star. Fuel scooping is an automatic process provided the fuel scoop is active. Only certain star types can provide fuel to be scooped. The rate of fuel gain is based on the quality and size of the scoop and by the proximity to the star in question. Be aware; remaining close to a star can cause your ship to suffer heat fatigue and potential destruction.

#### What is EDDB?

EDDB is a website which tries to act as a database of all the data available in the game. In general EDDB tries to help finding stuff which players are looking for.

#### Where does the data on EDDB come from?

The data which can be found on EDDB is 100% community generated. There is no regular data dump from Frontier. Systems, stations, commodity prices, outfitting or shipyard information - all this information is 100% coming from the actual player base.

#### How can you help keeping the data on EDDB up to date?

Short answer: Use a program like **EDMC** while playing the game, and every time you visit a system or a station, EDDB is being updated with the latest data.

Long answer: Not only EDDB but most of the Elite community websites are connected to a real time data network called EDDN. The basic idea is that players use an EDDN client while playing the game and for instance if the player docks on a station, the latest station information is being transmitted to the EDDN network. Every website which supports EDDN gets those updates immediately. There are many client programs, offering different kinds of functionality. However, one simple client is EDMC, so I recommend this one for starters.

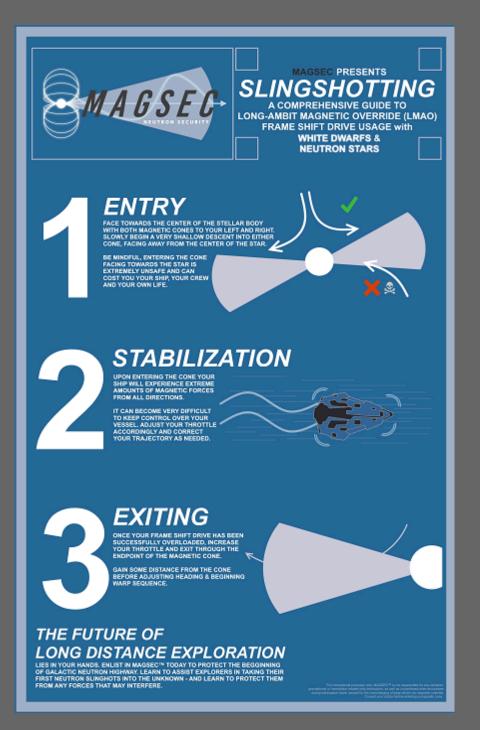

#### What is FSD Supercharging?

FSD supercharging is the process of flying into a high-energy relativistic jet of a neutron star or a white dwarf in supercruise with a Fuel Scoop equipped, which increases the FSD range for the next jump at the cost of slight damage to the Frame Shift Drive itself.

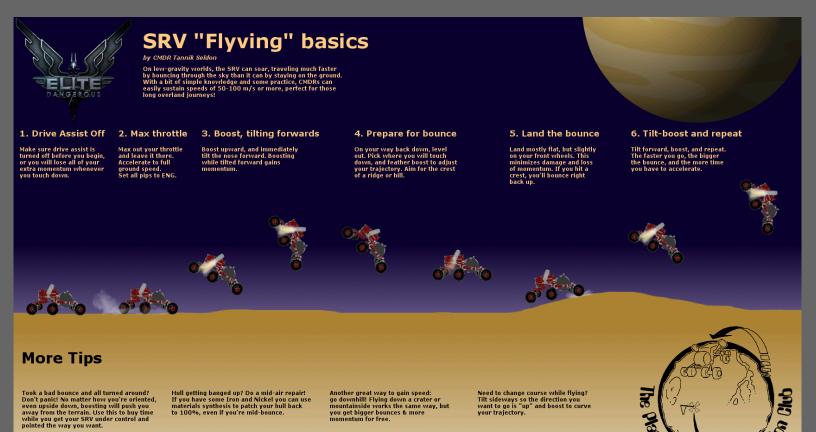
FSD supercharging from a white dwarf gives a 50% (1.5x multiplier) range bonus, while doing the same with a neutron star provides a 300% (4x multiplier) bonus, effectively quadrupling a ship's range for a single jump. Note that supercharging is not an instant process, and the pilots may have to spend several seconds inside the jet for the effect to apply.

This is a risky process, as the high-energy jet of the star can fling the ship around and make it difficult to control, and disengaging supercruise while inside the jet will strain and inflict damage to a ship's modules and hull.

Independently-charted Neutron Highways can be used to traverse vast differences with far fewer jumps than the conventional method of travel.

Another great way to gain speed: go downhill! Flying down a crater or mountainside works the same way, but you get bigger bounces & more momentum for free.

Hull getting banged up? Do a mid-air repair! If you have some Iron and Nickel you can use materials synthesis to patch your hull back to 100%, even if you're mid-bounce.

Need to change course while flying? Tilt sideways so the direction you want to go is "up" and boost to curve your trajectory.

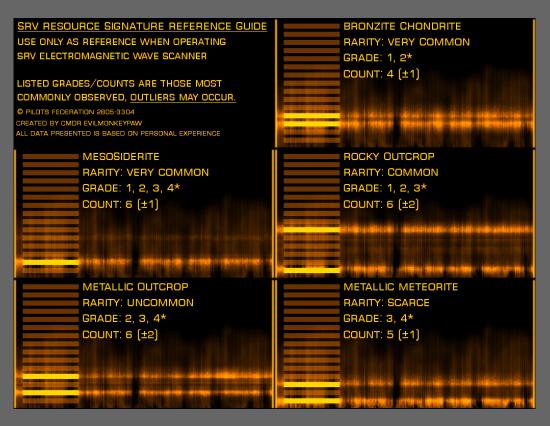

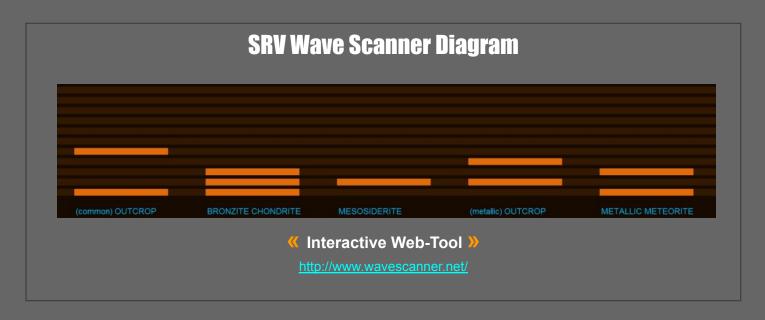
Surface Recon Vehicles (SRV) serve as a way to maneuver on a planetary surface. Depending on the gravity of the planet the SRV handles differently. The only available SRV at present is the Scarab. Ships can store it with the Planetary Vehicle Hangar. SRVs have a Wave Scanner which is a unidirectional long-range forward facing scanner that detects a variety of vehicles and points of interest.

The Planetary Vehicle Hangar module provides the on-board hangar space to carry and repair an SRV, which is purchased separately from the Hangar module. This may use an Internal Compartment. Any SRV damage is automatically repaired upon returning to the ship. If the player dies in their SRV, they will return to their ship, regardless of if it's still landed, or has taken off automatically.

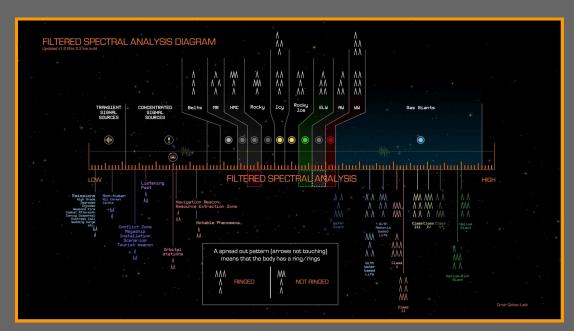

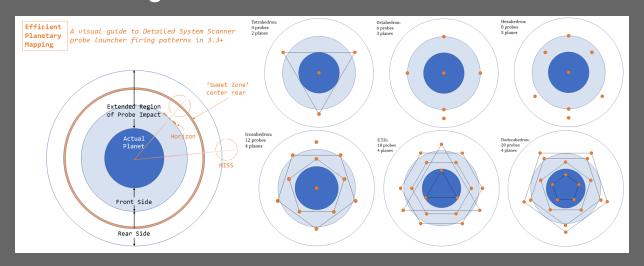

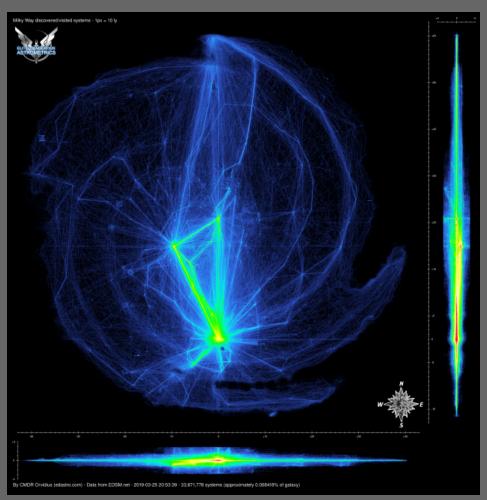

All charts and maps generated using data collected by EDSM. All data is based on scanned bodies, and/or visited systems, so the numbers can be influenced by commander activity as much as actual distribution. The unusual patterns that emerge from some of the specific filtered maps are largely due to quirks of Stellar Forge, and there can be large variations between the distribution patterns of certain mass codes or certain star classes.



Maps and spreadsheets are updated once every two days.

The Engineers are known individuals that can modify your ship's <u>weapons</u> and <u>modules</u>. The <u>Horizons</u> expansion is required to access them as they reside in planetary bases. Engineers can only modify a specific set of weapons and modules depending upon their lore and preference. Some engineers are suited more for <u>explorers</u> whilst others for <u>bounty hunters</u>.

In total there are 24 engineers. Before you can get an invite to an Engineer's base you must learn about them first, either through common knowledge or from hearing about them through other Engineers.

### **Experimental Effects**

An Experimental Effect, formerly known as a Special Effect, is a bonus modification that can be applied to a weapon or module that already has a Grade 1-5 Engineer modification. In exchange for small quantities of up to four different Materials, an Engineer will apply a chosen Experimental Effect that can further enhance the modifications potency or balance out its shortcomings. While most Experimental Effects can be applied to a wide variety of weapons and modules, some are exclusive to only one. Experimental Effects can only be applied at Engineer Workshops, not remotely.

Each blueprint specifies which materials are needed, and how to get them; material sources include (but are not limited to) destroyed ships, mission rewards, ship/wake scans, signal sources, mining, planetary surface resources, and more.

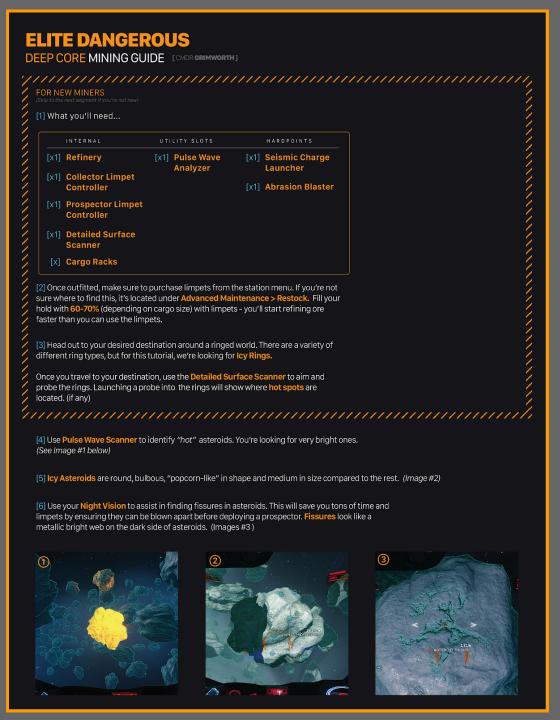

# **Galactic Powers**

As it has been throughout recorded history, mankind is not very prone to agreement over ethical, political, religious, and economic views. It remains this way today in the 34th Century, with the realm of human-colonized space held by numerous groups under various ideals, some benevolent and others not quite as much.

There are Three Galactic Superpowers in the Human-inhabited Core Systems of the Milky Way Galaxy:

- The <u>Federation</u> A representative democracy based out of <u>Sol</u>, founded in 2242. It has the largest population (2.5 trillion), territory (5,969 systems), and GDP (gross domestic product) of the superpowers.
- The <u>Empire</u> An elective monarchy based out of <u>Achenar</u>, founded in 2296. It has the second-largest population (1.8 trillion), territory (5,257 systems), and GDP of the superpowers.
- The <u>Alliance</u> A democratic confederation based out of <u>Alioth</u>, founded in 3230. It has the third-largest population (491 billion), territory (847 systems), and GDP of the superpowers.

Another group of note is the <u>Pilots Federation</u>, which oversees the vast majority of the actions taken by privately-owned vessels in human space, but which does not directly involve itself in political affairs. Instead the pilots within this group hire themselves out as <u>mercenaries</u> or operate as benefactors to other factions, for monetary gain or otherwise.

# Powerplay

Powerplay represents the machinations of powerful individuals and organizations that strive to control inhabited space for their own agendas. At its heart, Powerplay is a battle for territory. Each Power attempts to expand into systems, extracting resources from them in order to pay for continued expansion and protect systems already being exploited. As commanders of space ships, players can pledge support to a power and carry out tasks for them in return for rewards and prestige

Medium ships are faster, cheaper to (re)buy, require less engineering, and pack roughly the same firepower as large ships due to the weapons cap on experimentals (4). For soloing Hydra, a large ship is recommended.

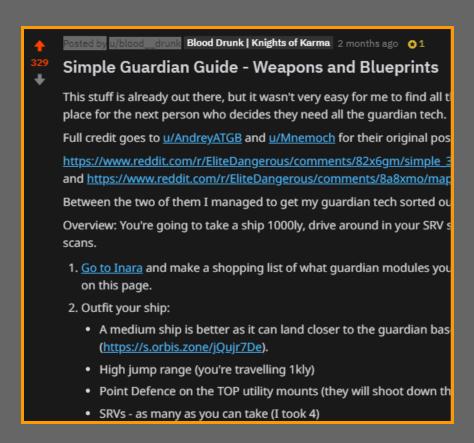

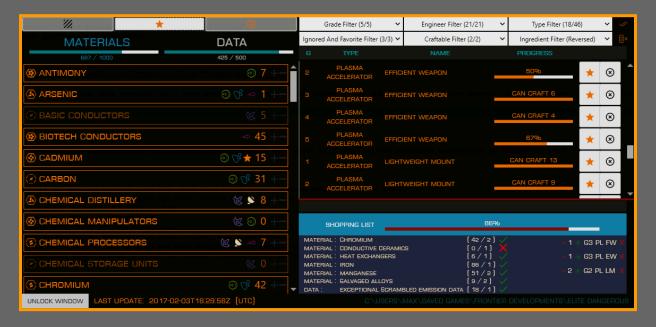

This app downloads your Cmdr's details and system, faction, scan and station data from the game Elite: Dangerous and, at your choice, either:

sends station commodity market prices, other station data, system and faction information and body scan data to the Elite Dangerous Data Network ("EDDN") from where you and others can use it via online trading, prospecting and shopping tools such as eddb, EDSM, Elite Trade Net, Inara, Roguey's, Trade Dangerous, etc.



for Plugins/Addons

- Send your Cmdr's details, ship details, cargo, materials and flight log to Elite: Dangerous Star Map.
- Send your Cmdr's details, ship details, cargo, materials, missions, community goal progress, and flight log to Inara.
- Saves station commodity market prices to files on your computer that you can load into trading tools such as Trade Dangerous or mEDI's Elite Tools.
  - Saves a record of your ship loadout to files on your computer that you can load into outfitting tools such as E:D Shipyard, Coriolis or Elite Trade Net.

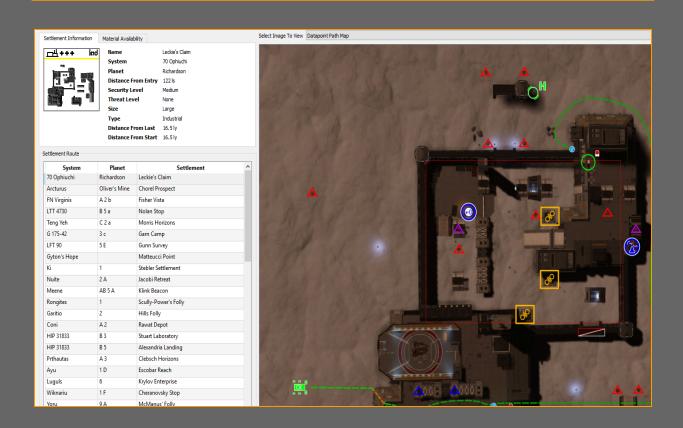
# **ED:Discovery**

It's primarily focused on making settlement data point farming easier, by allowing you to pick the materials you're interested in, and get an optimal route to reach as many systems you wish that match the query. For performance reasons, the path is limited to at most 100 systems

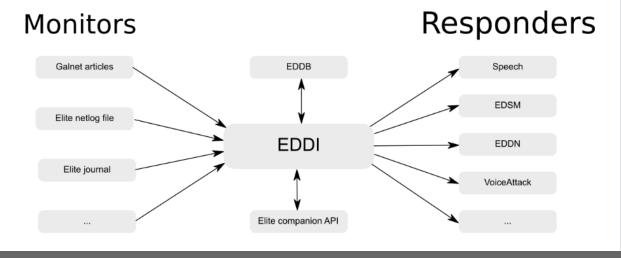

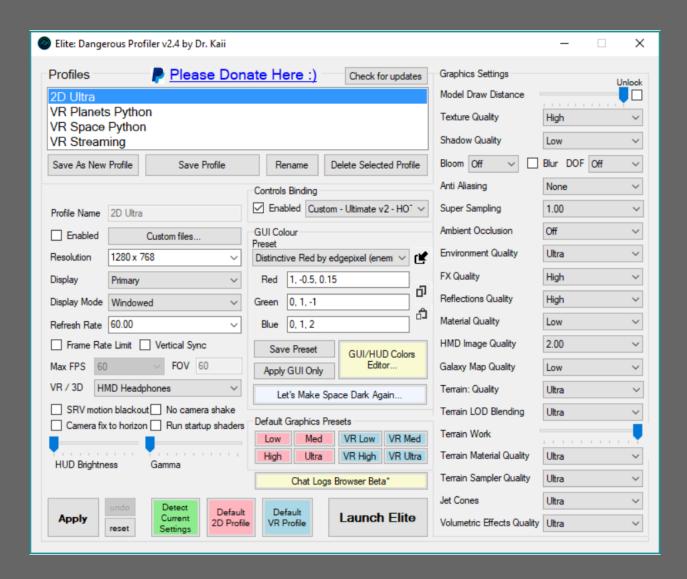

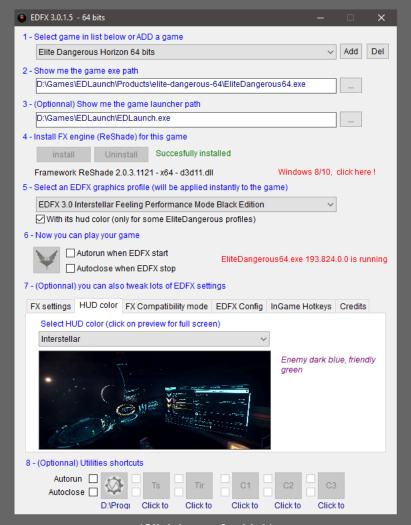

#### Prepare your ship for Rescue





- 1. Exit supercruise and set throttle to O
- In the modules tab of your systems panel, disable all modules except for Life Support and Power Plant
- Check your fuel consumption. If not at 0.00/h, you will
  eventually run out of fuel to power your life support! Please
  obtain the below information quickly.

#### Get your location details



Note: A screenshot of this panel can help, particularly if you have to log out!

- Obtain your current system from your Navigation panel e.g. COL 285 Sector NE-R A34-2
- 2. If you are not within 10,000Ls of the system's star (top of the list), note the distances to help the Fuel Rats find you!
  e.g. 832,163Ls from star, in direction of COL 285 Sector OE-R A34-0



If you see an oxygen depletion timer on your display, log out once you have your location details, and notify the Fuel Rats that a CASE RED rescue is needed! Note how much time is remaining as it will be important in coordinating your rescue

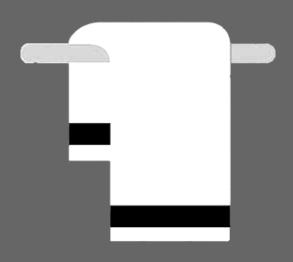
