What is Open Austin?

Open Austin is a volunteer citizen brigade advocating for open government, open data, and civic application development since 2009. Open Austin is an official brigade affiliated with Code for America, a 501(c)(3), which believes government can work for the people, by the people in the 21st century. As a part of a national movement we design & build open source technology and organize a network of people dedicated to making government services simple, effective, and easy to use.

What are Civic Hack Nights?

Open Austin's monthly Civic Hack Night is a hands on meet up for "civic hackers" interested in contributing to civic apps. Developers, designers, writers, data analysis, policy wonks and people of all skill levels are encouraged to attend.

Our evening starts with brief announcements and project updates. After project updates, we will split into breakout groups to help with learning, conversation, and project work.

Key results include:

- Building a community of technologists and designers who believe their individual ideas and contributions can make Austin a more open city with better civic services.
- Provide an inclusive environment for discussion, team formation, and learning.
- Move forward civic and social good projects.
