General education course requirements are listed assuming that major classes will not count toward the general education course requirements. If a course counts towards a major and a general education requirement (e.g. PSYC 101 if the student is a psychology major), students will still need to take (shown here as Graduation Hr Req) enough courses to reach the 128 credits needed to graduate.

**This degree requires 4 additional courses to fulfill the graduation hour requirement of 128. Students should consider using these 4 courses to add a minor or a second concentration. Minors range from 4-7 courses. Speak with a School of Business advisor to map out what would fit best in your degree.

Departmental Requirements

- In all courses, including non-business courses, students must achieve a cumulative 2.5 GPA or higher.
- In business courses alone, students must separately achieve a cumulative 2.5 GPA or higher.
- A grade of C- or higher is required for all business and supplemental foundation courses required for the major.
- A minimum of 28 semester hours (7 courses) must be taken in residence at PLU.
- Business degree and concentration requirements are established at the time of major declaration.
- Upper-division business course access is limited to students who have been admitted to the School of Business.
- Students may only choose to Pass/Fail one (1) supplemental class from MATH 128, ECON 101, or STAT
 231. All other supplemental courses and business courses cannot be taken Pass/Fail, except for BUSA 495:
 Internship which is only offered Pass/Fail. For more information on Pass/Fail, see the Pass/Fail section of
 the University Catalog.
- Note: Students with a declared major in business who have not attended the University for a period of three
 years or more will be held to the business degree requirements in affect at the time of re-entry to the
 University. Transfer and continuing students should see the catalog under which they entered the program
 and consult with the undergraduate coordinator regarding degree requirements.

General Degree Requirements

- A minimum of 128 semester hours must be completed with a GPA of 2.00 or higher.
- In addition to the requirements of this major, students must complete all other requirements of the University as listed in the catalog.
- At least 32 semester hours must be completed in residence at PLU.
- At least 8 semester hours for the major must be taken in residence at PLU.
- All students must complete a minimum of 40 semester hours of Upper-Division work (300-400 level) which includes courses in the major.
- Students should earn 32 semester hours per year to stay on track to graduate in 4-years (which requires a minimum of 128 semester hours).
