- Discussion topic: Hiring practices and equity issues: How can we make our hiring practices accessible and equitable? We will be sharing tips and experiences about what works, what doesn't, and how we can help our institutions improve in this area.
 - Providing questions to candidates ahead of time
 - Make questions simpler and to the point -- not multiple questions in one
 - Give candidates choice of having a meal with others (not from hiring committee) or lunch on their own
 - Rethinking job descriptions to be more accessible from outset -- remove personality requirements, ableist requirements
 - Charisma Bias (such a real thing!!)
 - Not having any preferred requirements in position descriptions. Eliminate things that can be trained on the job from being job requirements
 - Always ask about accommodation needs esp for meals -- ideally these go through someone who is not on the search committee
 - Share workplace dress code
 - Share information about presentation space (photos, tech info)
 - Excellence / DEI advocates on search committees
 - Cut down on length of interview day

- a. D shared an interesting article: Hyeonjin Bak, Ines Jurcevic & Sophie Trawalter (2024). "What black people value when white people confront prejudice," The Journal of Social Psychology, 164:2, 187-198, DOI: 10.1080/00224545.2023.2178875
- b. Carrie shared modifications to hiring procedures/interview processes that are designed to make the process more inclusive. These include sharing themes of interview questions ahead of time, and sharing information (photos, written description) of the space in which candidates will give a presentation.
- c. Dan reported they are creating a reading group in the library and hoping to go more deeply into DEI issues. Also there is a CRT collaborative that is forming and will be hosting a zoom session.
- d. Patrick's colleagues wrote a Libguide about <u>Researching Palestine</u> in the context of the 2023 crisis in Palestine. [Unfortunately this guide has been unpublished until such a time as the policies and protections of the authors and contributors can be understood and enforced]
- e. Neel's institution launched a new digital collection—a student newspaper from the 1970's focused on a Latinx student newspaper:

 https://digitalcollections.lmu.edu/collections/vida This is the first collection of many, the next is a Black student newspaper, and then an oral history collection of disabled students on campus, and then religious objects from South Asia.

 Also hired a DEIA metadata librarian to help with this project.
- f. Mark's group is looking at the metadata in their ArchivesSpace instance, students working on it as well.
- g. Jeannette–SB17, the anti-DEI act went into effect January1; it bans diversity offices on campus or any policies related to "differential treatment." Also can't use things like diversity statements in hiring. But, it doesn't apply to teaching or research or student organizations or guest speakers, or student admissions recruitment. AAUP has been helping to clarify what's allowed. The readers "rater law" has been blocked. But collection development standards have to be established for schools, which could impact the diversity of collections since these laws tend to target sexual preference and under-represented communities.
- h. Kim: hosting a Diversity in Children's Lit event in March, we are planning an all school training for cultural sensitivity, we have a DEIA Coordinator as of this academic year.
