

# Branching Out

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## Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets:** Branching Out (165771)
- **Card Stock and Paper:** Very Vanilla (166784), Early Espresso (119686), Shaded Spruce (146981), Real Red (102482), Country Woods DSP (163393)
- **Stamp Pads:** Early Espresso (147114), Real Red (147084), Shaded Spruce (147088)
- **Tools:** Branching Out dies (165775),
- **Miscellaneous:** Black & White & Gold Baker's Twine (166005), Traditional Sparkling Sequins (165875), (Stampin'Dimensionals (104430); Stampin' Seal Adhesive (152813)

## Measurements:

- Early Espresso: 4 1/4" x 11", scrap
- Shaded Spruce: Scrap
- Real Red: Scrap
- Very Vanilla: 5/8" x 3"
- DSP: 4" x 5 1/4"
- Twine: 12"

## Instructions:

1. Cut a 4 1/4" x 11" Early Espresso card base. Fold in half.
2. Cut the woodgrain designer paper to 4" x 5 1/4"
3. Stamp the branches onto the designer paper using Early Espresso ink.
4. Stamp the pines onto the branches using Shaded Spruce ink.
5. Stamp the berries using Real Red ink.
6. Adhere the designer paper to the card front.
7. Cut a 5/8" x 3" piece of Very Vanilla cardstock.
8. Stamp the sentiment onto the cardstock using Early Espresso ink. Trim the left side of the sentiment on a diagonal.
9. Tie a large bow from the White/Gold Baker's Twine.
10. Adhere the bow to the BACKSIDE of the sentiment.
11. Adhere the sentiment to the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.
12. Cut the branch from Early Espresso cardstock.
13. Cut the pines from Shaded Spruce cardstock. Snip the pines and adhere to the branch.
14. Cut the berries from Real Red cardstock.
15. Tuck and adhere the branch and berries behind the sentiment.
16. Adhere (3) red sequins randomly to the card front.
