

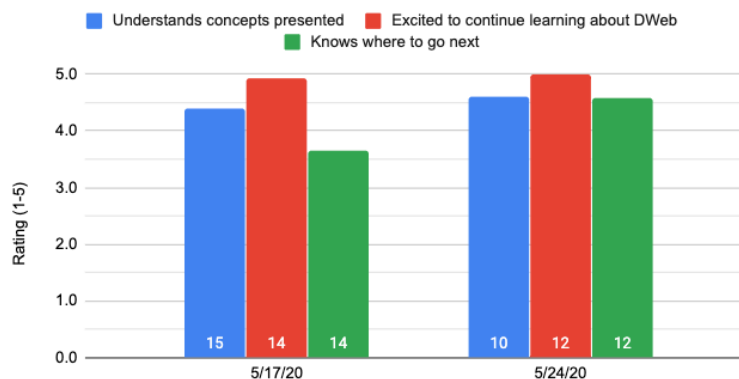

The IPFS Regular Files API provides a way to store and share files in a peer-to-peer storage system.

Anatomy of a CID



A content identifier, or CID, is a label used to point to data stored on distributed information systems including IPFS, IPLD, libp2p, and Filecoin. It doesn't indicate where the content is stored, but it forms a kind of address based on the content itself.
