These senators did an excellent job defending these bills against the lunacy and degrading question from the Democrats. In addition to these bills they also worked hard to support other pro-family/pro-life bills passed.

Senator Grall- Sponsored

- [SB 300- Pregnancy and Parenting Support](#) aka The Heartbeat Bill, this bill also greatly increased the funding for pregnancy centers.
- [SB 266- Higher Education](#) (The Florida College System is prohibited from teaching systemic racism, sexism, oppression and privilege in violation of Florida Equal Education Act, AND general education core courses may not distort significant historical events or teach identity politics and specified concepts related to discrimination.
- [SB 130- Domestic Violence](#) - The bill expands the list of factors a court must consider when determining whether shared parental responsibility, meaning shared authority to make decisions for a child, would be detrimental to a child.

Senator Clay Yarborough- (I met him the day moved into his House of Representative Office in 2016. From day 1 he has been a champion for life.)

- [S 254- Treatments for Sex Reassignment](#)- The bill defines “sex” to mean the classification of a person as either male or female based on the organization of the human body, ***Prohibition Against Expenditure of State Funds, and*** prohibits sex-reassignment prescription or procedure provided to a person younger than 18 years of age. (read for more information)
- [S 1438- Protection of Children](#) (Prohibits a person from knowingly admitting a child to an adult live performance. (No drag shows for kids.)
- [CS 1069 - Child Protection in Public Schools](#)- The bill includes requirements for age-appropriate and developmentally appropriate instruction for all students in prekindergarten through grade 12, enhances the process for transparency...(addresses the sex-education curriculums in our public schools!).

Representative Mike Beltran- Our local representative Life Champion highlights Mike Beltran (Hillsborough) who has been working since he got elected in 2018 to get the heartbeat bill passed. The companion bill to SB 300 (Typically women are chosen to be sponsors in both the house and senate. Rep. Beltran was one of the first representatives to co-sponsor HB-07. He sponsored a “Surrender Newborn Infant” bill which many states have passed. We need to work on this next year!
