

Daly City - Safe Routes

Collective Impact Project: 2019 (2018-19 & 2019-20)

Big Picture

This project has Daly City as the core central focus of the work, with the objective of creating Safe Routes across the entire city for all schools (and potentially parks, senior citizens centers, etc. in the long term). That means that each of the school sites (and their corresponding goals and issues) are just a piece of the bigger complex system. The Collective Impact Project seeks to pilot a process that brings key stakeholders together and support them to move through both long-term visioning and goal setting, and short term action and success. If success is made here, it is a process that could be scaled up across Daly City, and then replicated in other cities.
