1. Download and open the app "Clever."




- 2. Scan their QR Code (located in the back of their take-home folder).
- 3. Click the box named "IXL."




4. At the top of the screen, there may be skills I have "starred". Work on the skills I have starred as it will be updated on what we are doing in the classroom!


5. If there are no starred recommendations, please find a skill you would like your child to work on. Here are directions:
