

Math IXL is a great resource for students to practice a skill we are working on in the classroom. Here are the steps to take to log into their IXL

Account:

The examples are given from a phone. The format may appear differently depending on the device.

1. Download and open the app "Clever."



2. Scan their QR Code (located in the back of their take-home folder).

3. Click the box named "IXL."



4. At the top of the screen, there may be skills I have "starred". Work on the skills I have starred as it will be updated on what we are doing in the classroom!

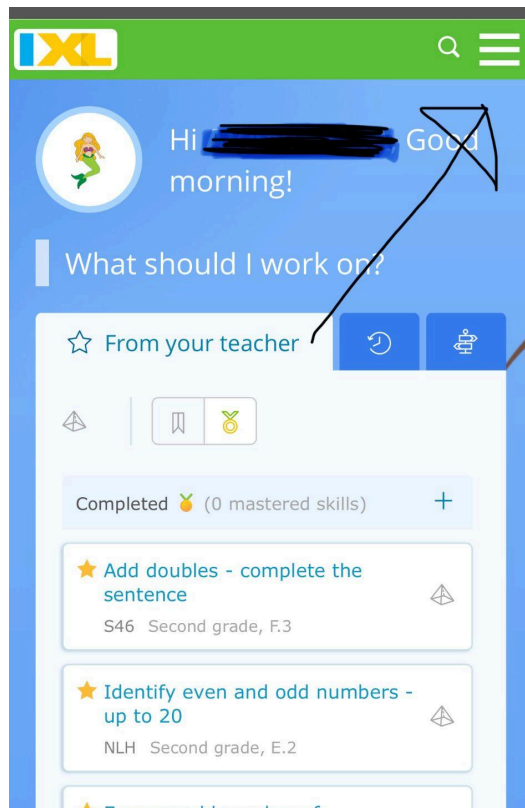

5. If there are no starred recommendations, please find a skill you would like your child to work on. Here are directions:

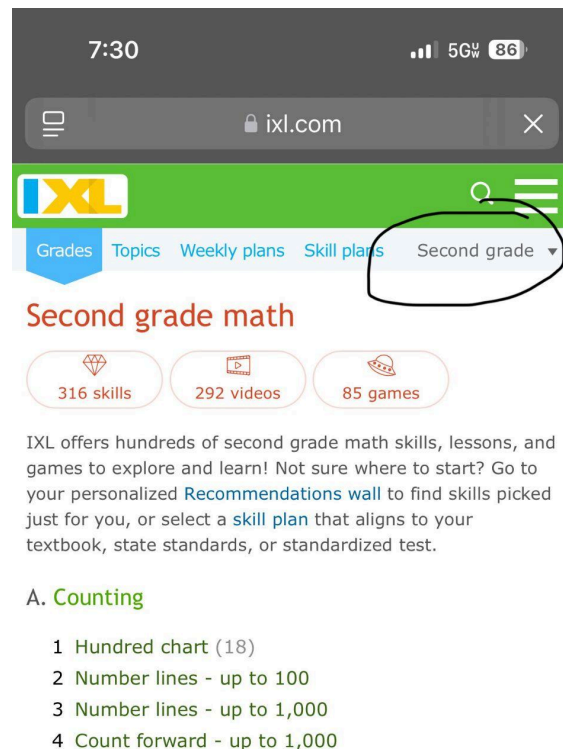
a. Click the three bars in top right corner.

- i. Addition strategies: one digit (F1, F2, F3, F5, F6, F7, F6)
- ii. Addition: one digit (G1-G12)
- iii. Subtraction strategies: one digit (H1-H7)
- iv. Subtraction: one digit (I1-I7)
- v. Place Value (L1-L16)
