Course Grading:

1. Daily Grades: 55%
 - a. Homework is due the next day when the tardy bell rings unless otherwise instructed. Homework can be corrected up to seventy, students are responsible for signing up and must follow all guidelines: the original question must be rewritten, all work must be shown, and the correct answer must be provided on notebook paper stapled to the original assignment. Corrections must be completed by the Thursday following the return of the graded assignments and must be done in Coach Hiles' classroom.
2. Tests/Quizzes: 35%
 - a. Students may be given the opportunity to correct a limited number of assessments to earn a maximum score of seventy. The availability of corrections will be determined by the teacher and may vary depending on the specific assessment. When corrections are allowed, students are responsible for signing up and must follow all guidelines: the original question must be rewritten, all work must be shown, and the correct answer must be provided on notebook paper stapled to the original assessment. Corrections must be completed by the Thursday following the return of the graded assessment and must be done in Coach Hiles' classroom. Please note that the six-week test given at the end of each grading period is not eligible for corrections.
3. Notes Grade: 10%
 - a. I will randomly check students' notes during the six weeks. You will NOT be able to correct these grades.

Late Work

1. The operational definition of late work is when a student has been provided adequate time and instruction to complete an assignment, and has not completed it by the due date. This includes all assignments and long-term projects. If a student does not turn in an assignment by the due date, then the student will have three school days to turn in the assignment late, and twenty-five points will be deducted.
 - a. If work is more than three school days late, it will result in a zero.
 - b. Late work will not be eligible for corrections.
