


## College Application Timeline (U.S. Students)

 **Purpose:** This timeline provides a structured overview of key milestones in the college application process. **It is divided by grade level and—once application season starts—month-by-month.**

<b>Grade 10</b>	Focus rigorous coursework (AP/Honors) on subjects where you're strongest/most interested.	Narrow ECs to 2-4 focus areas (academic & non-academic).  Take leadership roles in meaningful activities. Join competitions.  Consider internships, research, and passion projects.	Take PSAT/NMSQT.  Take practice ACT & SAT to compare.  If completed Algebra II, take first SAT/ACT.	Research schools broadly & major options.	
<b>Grade 11</b>	Advance with rigorous coursework in key academic subjects. Identify potential major/minor subjects.	Deepen commitment to top extracurriculars.  Deepen activities in your core focus areas (academic and non-academic).	Take SAT/ACT (up to 3 times if needed) soonest after completing Algebra II.	Research schools & major options.  <b>Request recommendation letters</b> with rec letter package.  Evaluate application strategies / personas.	Research need-based vs. merit-based financial aid.  Research scholarships.

Formatting, typos, etc.  <b>“Preview” all application materials as PDF.</b>  Finalize regular decision school list.	Submit FAFSA.  Submit CSS Profile for private schools and other school-specific forms.  Apply for external scholarships.

Summer before College				Finalize travel plans, register for orientation.	Ensure tuition & housing payments are arranged.

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
