NOTE: Per your feedback, we have tweaked the schedule as follows:

- Two days of competition (Fri & Sat.) to allow for family time on Sunday
- We will have a SuperPutt for Cash Thursday Night at Registration, as well as an OPTIONAL Whiskey Tasting, and Poker Tournament Thursday Night
- We will still have our flighted Cross-Country Par 3
 Tournament, with payouts/flight

Local Rules

USGA rules apply to all play.

All marked drainage ditches are treated as obstructions and given free relief.

NOTE: <u>To Improve Pace of Play -</u> We will <u>not</u> be playing out of yellow marked environmentally sensitive areas on the golf course, (marked by yellow stakes). Drop areas will be marked.

The retaining wall against the 13th green is considered an obstruction. If the wall interferes with a player's swing or stance the player may take relief without penalty. The relief is stance clear of the wall interference plus one club length, no closer to the hole.

If your ball is in the penalty area short of the fairway (Hole #7), you have the <u>option</u> to proceed to the drop area .

For Hole #11, fence line/white markers is OOB line For Hole #12 - left of the cart path is OOB line For Hole #15 -Home owner property, in bushes, or against retaining wall is considered OOB

<u>Course Markings</u> - White stakes and lines along boundary of course-out of bounds. White lines within the course boundary-ground under repair. Red stakes and lines - penalty area. Yellow stakes and lines - penalty area.

<u>Penalty</u> - Any rules infraction shall be evaluated by the Head Golf Professional.

If the ruling is in question, play a second ball and record both scores. The player must stipulate which ball he intends to score.

For **Tournament Handicaps - June 15**

Format:

Thursday Competition:

- <u>SuperPutt for \$\$\$ INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION -</u> each player will have 2 balls to putt,
 - o **Top 5 closest will win cash** (tbd by # of Buy-Ins).
 - Addtl. putts can be purchased for \$5/putt

Friday Competition:

We will be playing two different 9 hole formats:

- Chapman & Select Drive, Alt Shot
- Select Drive/Alternate Shot
 - Minimum of 2 drives per player per 9 holes
- Friday afternoon is an 18-hole Flighted Cross Country Par 3 Tournament
 - * Select Drive/Alternate Shot
 - * Min of 4 drives per player

<u>Par 3 Tournament Purse</u>: Each flight will pay; 1st Place \$120/team, 2nd Place \$80/team and 3rd Place \$40/team - CASH

Note—All golf played both Friday & Saturday including Par 3
Tournament counts toward the tournament point total

<u>Saturday Competition:</u>

We will be playing two different 9 hole formats:

- <u>Select Drive -Best Ball</u> Players will select the best drive and each play their own ball from there.
 - Minimum of 2 drives per player
- <u>Select Drive Both Balls</u> Players will select the best drive and each play their own ball from there
 - Minimum of 2 drives per player
 - Both balls are counted for team total stableford points

Scoring, all 9 hole rounds:

Stableford Scoring:

To encourage speed of play; if you reach a <u>NET</u> double bogey on any hole, there is no need to continue playing the hole because you have reached your maximum score.

Points:

Double Bogey or Worse	-1
Bogey	+1
Par	+2
Birdie	+3
Eagle	+4
Double Eagle	+5

Competition/Payouts:

- Hole in One Competition for \$10,000 Hole #3 from ~150 Yards
 - o HIO Contests will be held both Friday and Saturday
- Par 3 tournament will pay out <u>Top 3 per flight</u>
 - 1st @ \$120/team
 - 2nd @ \$80/team
 - 3rd @ \$40/team
- KP's will be held on all Par 3's each day per Flight
 - \$40/ each, per flight
- <u>Daily</u> Purse: <u>Top 3 per flight</u>, <u>per 9 hole event</u>
 - o 1st @ \$60
 - o 2nd @ \$40
 - o 3rd @ \$20
- Skins @ \$720 Pot/Day
 - Gross @ \$290 total payout/day
 - Net @ \$430 total payout/day
- Flight Winners @ \$100/team
- Horserace
 - 1st @ \$450
 - o 2nd @ \$350
 - 3rd @ \$250
 - o 4th @ \$200

Pari-Mutual:

To add to the excitement of our event., Thursday Night & Friday night, members have the opportunity to place Pari-Mutuel bets on any team they feel may finish in **the top 3 for the tournament.**Each bet will be \$10 on Thursday and \$20/bet on Friday - the member will be able to place as many bets on as many teams as desired.

At the end of the event, we will pay out the total money collected to the top three <u>overall</u> finishers after out Flight Winners Horserace.

<u>Team Finish</u>	<u>Payout</u>
First	50%
Second	30%
Third	20%

Individual payouts to wagers will be determined by the total number of winning coupons sold for each winning position (first, second, third).

2025 Side Games

The Side Games **\$50 CASH per person** includes entry into, Gross/Net Skins, Closets to the Pin, and the Par 3 Tournament.

- **Gross and Net Skins**, on the 9 hole events, one score per team on both Friday and Saturday.
- Closets to the Pin, all Par 3's, for each flight, both Friday & Saturday
- Par 3 Tournament, 18 holes, will pay out top 3 teams per Flight. Ties will split the money.
