NOTE: Per your feedback, we have again tweaked the schedule as follows:

- Two days of competition (Fri & Sat.) to allow for family time on Sunday
- We will have an OPTIONAL Whiskey Tasting & Cigar offering on Thursday Night
- We will play four different 9-hole formats
- We will use Stableford scoring for all 4 nine hole events
- We will still have our flighted 9-hole Cross-Country Par 3 Tournament, with payouts/flight
- We will have 4 flights of 13 teams per flight
- We will still have payouts daily, for each 9 hole event/flight
- We will still have flighted Closest to the Pin on all Par 3's for each day
- We will have a Skins Pot (Gross and Net) each day
- We will have a Hole-In-One Competition for \$10,000 each day on Hole #3 from 150 yds.
- The Top 2 point earning teams per flight, as well as two additional "wildcard" teams will enter our Championship Horserace
- For ties at the end of regulation tournament, we will play a Par 3 from hole #9 - **tee distance will be dictated by your Individual Handicap**
- We will play four holes in the Horserace to crown our 2026 MM Championship Team, with addtl. payouts to the Top 5 teams
- We will have an Awards Ceremony at dinner Saturday Night that includes bringing back an "old Plateau tradition" for MM Winners, as well as MM Logo'd Champions Golf Bags

- *Each player will also receive cocktail drink tickets for Friday and Saturday - 3 cocktail drink tickets for Friday, and 3 cocktail drink tickets for Saturday.

Additional drinks may be purchased and charged to your membership account (\$6.60++/drink).

Non-alcoholic beverages will be available throughout the tournament, stocked in coolers on the course.

Local Rules

USGA rules apply to all play.

All marked drainage ditches are treated as obstructions and given free relief.

NOTE:

The retaining wall against the 13th green is considered an obstruction. If the wall interferes with a player's swing or stance the player may take relief without penalty. The relief is stance clear of the wall interference plus one club length, no closer to the hole.

If your ball is in the penalty area short of the fairway (Hole #7), you have the option to proceed to the drop area .

For Hole #11, fence line/white markers is OOB line

For Hole #12 - left of the cart path is OOB line

For Hole #15 -Home owner property, in bushes, or against retaining wall is considered OOB

Course Markings - White stakes and lines along boundary of course-out of bounds. White lines within the course boundary-ground under repair. Red stakes and lines - penalty area. Yellow stakes and lines - penalty area.

Penalty - Any rules infraction shall be evaluated by the Head Golf Professional.

If the ruling is in question, play a second ball and record both scores. The player must stipulate which ball he intends to score.

Formats to be used Friday & Saturday:

AM- Friday Competition:

We will be playing two different 9 hole formats:

- **Chapman**
 - 60% of the lower hcp + 40% of the higher hcp
- **2man Best Ball**
 - 85% of individual course hcp's

- **Friday afternoon is an 9-hole Flighted Cross Country Par 3 Tournament**
 - * Select Drive/Alternate Shot
 - * Min of 3 drives per player

After Lunch we will go out for our Par 3 Tournament with Purse at \$2,000

Each flight will pay; 1st Place \$120/team, 2nd Place \$100/team, 3rd Place \$80/team, 4th place @ \$60, 5th place @ \$50, 6th place @ \$40, 7th place @ \$ 30, and 8th place @ \$20 - **CASH**

Saturday Competition:

We will be playing two different 9 hole formats:

- **True Alternate Shot** - Team will select who drives on Odd holes and their partner will drive on Even holes
 - **50% of combined team hcp**

- **Select Drive - Both Balls** - Players will select the best drive and each play their own ball from there
 - Minimum of 2 drives per player
 - Both balls are counted for team total stableford points
 - **85% of individual course hcp's**

Scoring, all 9 hole rounds:

Stableford Scoring:

To encourage speed of play; if you reach a NET double bogey on any hole, there is no need to continue playing the hole because you have reached your maximum score.

Points:

Double Bogey or Worse	-1
Bogey	+1
Par	+2
Birdie	+3
Eagle	+4
Double Eagle	+5

To qualify for the Championship Horserace:

- First and Second from each of the four flights
- + Top 2 teams not coming in 1st or 2nd in their flight earn a spot in the Horserace

We will stay firm on 10 teams by entering a sudden death playoff to break all ties and earn your way into the shootout.

Playoff details:

- We will start with playoffs for any flights and then move into any playoff for the wildcard spots.
- Playoff will be a manufactured par 3 to be chosen by Cam & Kevin
- Hole will be somewhere with clear viewing from the deck/balcony
- **Format will be select drive alternate shot**
- In live time there will be para-mutual betting available on the deck for teams that are in the shootout. As teams win a playoff, parimutuel labels will be updated @ \$20/bet.

Shootout Details:

- **4 playoff holes, 10 teams, select drive alternate shot.**
- Eliminate 2 teams on 17, 3 teams on 18, and 2 teams on 1 to have 3 teams play a final hole on hole 9.
- **Ties on holes 17, 18, and 1 will be broken by a chip off decided by Cameron.**
 - **Player who did not hole out must chip-off**
- Ties on hole 9 for the overall champion will be broken by a sudden death playoff
 - Modified Par-3 using hole 9
 - Starting distances used for hcp instead of dots
 - 3 possible tees for all participants
 - Cam will decide distances
- Any ties on hole 9 for second place will be broken by a chip off to settle all parimutuel bets

Competition/Payouts:

- **Hole in One Competition** for \$10,000 - Hole #3 from ~150 Yards
 - HIO Contests will be held both Friday and Saturday
- **Par 3 tournament** will pay out **Top 8 per flight**
 - 1st @ \$120/team
 - 2nd @ \$100
 - 3rd @ \$80
 - 4th @ \$60
 - 5th @ \$50
 - 6th @ \$40
 - 7th @ \$30
 - 8th @ \$20
- **KP's** will be held on all Par 3's each day **per Flight**
 - \$50/ each, per flight
- **Daily Purse: Top 3 per flight, per 9 hole event**
 - 1st @ \$80
 - 2nd @ \$60
 - 3rd @ \$30
- **Skins @ \$750 Pot/Day**
 - Gross @ \$300 total payout/dayNet @ \$450 total payout/day

- **Final Top 2 in each Flight** @ \$120/team and \$100/team
 - NOTE - the two wildcard teams that get into the Horserace will have a chance to earn addtl. dollars by finishing in the Top 5 (not part of above \$120 & \$100 above)

- **Horserace Pay Out to Top 5:**
 - 1st @ \$600
 - 2nd @ \$400
 - 3rd @ \$200
 - 4th @ \$100
 - 5th @ \$80

Pari-Mutual:

To add to the excitement of our event., Thursday Night & Friday night, members have the opportunity to place Pari-Mutuel bets on any team they feel may finish in **the top 3 for the tournament.** Each bet will be \$10 on Thursday and \$20/bet on Friday - the member will be able to place as many bets on as many teams as desired.

At the end of the event, we will pay out the total money collected to the top three overall finishers after our Flight Winners Horserace.

<u>Team Finish</u>	<u>Payout</u>
First	50%
Second	30%
Third	20%

NEW for 2026 MM Tournament:

- We will have an opportunity to place additional Pari-Mutual bets BEFORE the Horserace
- 10 teams will advance to the Horserace, you can bet on who you think will come in First, Second or Third
- \$20 bets/team selected

Note—All golf played both Friday & Saturday NOT INCLUDING THE PAR 3 TOURNAMENT (per your feedback) counts toward the tournament point total this year.

2026 Side Games

The Side Games **\$50 CASH per person** includes entry into, Gross/Net Skins, Closets to the Pin, and the Par 3 Tournament.

- **Gross and Net Skins**, on the 9 hole events, one score per team on both Friday and Saturday.
- **Closets to the Pin**, all Par 3's, for each flight, both Friday & Saturday
- **Par 3 Tournament**, holes, will pay out top 8 teams per Flight. Ties will split the money.
