Zoom Meet Code of Conduct:

Rules:

- Delegates must be dressed appropriately; thus, formal wear is expected from the delegates
- Cameras must be turned on at all times, with the appropriate backgrounds administered by the secretariat.
- All behavior must adhere to the ACS Student Guidebook
- Microphone must be working
- DO NOT exit zoom (between sessions (in breaks), simply turn mic and camera off).

Features:

- Zoom specific procedure
 - Done through the poll tool of Zoom
 - Point & Motions: said aloud, any seconds will be voiced through the chat, any objections must be spoken aloud
 - Points of personal privilege pertaining to audibility must be voiced through the chat: under no circumstances may you interrupt a speaker
 - Direct messaging with the chairs or other delegates will be carried out through zoom
- Chair responsibilities
 - Chairs are asked to create rooms with specific purposes:
 - Main room, used as a lobby.
 - A session room used for the process of debating.
 - An emergency room.
 - Chairs also have the freedom to create breakout rooms rooms based on their own judgements
