Stores:

MicroCenter

I've heard that they're increasing measures to limit sales to 1 per person...per 30 days. Not bad. I've had friends go and get one that day, without planning as well. Your experience might differ based on the location and time you go, but a lot still are queueing. Haven't had a reason yet to go myself.

Newegg

Don't forget to do the shuffle every day. It's basically a free lotto ticket to get scalped, as you usually have to buy something else (and return if so) along side it. Usually RAM and Motherboards, but I've seen EVGA's capture box and a few other items there.

The biggest thing to look out for are Gigabyte PSU's. It's a known issue now, but Newegg dumped their inventory on Shuffle winners. You can look up the Gamers Nexus video(s) on it if you're into the techy details, but I'd just consider it e-waste and woudn't even consider plugging it in. Don't dissasemble it either - just dispose of properly or make it a conversation piece in your home.

Amazon

Don't bother. You might get lucky but it's the easiest to bot currently. Want a CPU? I had to leave NerdSpeak and rejoin because I was getting flooded with AMD CPU alerts. Those might be better supplied still, which is a strong improvment.

B&H/Adorama

These get covered by those above alert services, I've had gpu's in my cart for a minute instead of a second. Most people don't know about these stores as much as the franchises.

BestBuy

Get that plugin and pay attention, the drops are telegraphed through the grapevine pretty well due to their market penetration in the US. I heard a rumor that the in-person drops have good store ratings, but could have been a disgruntled store manager on reddit.

Walmart

They cancelled my Ryzen order before I got one. No other experience so far with it. Maybe try for a console here instead? Seems more likely to show up there.

ADD IN BOARD PARTNERS

It sure is a great year to be a unpopular AIB IMHO, since people will take any card right now.

EVGA

Get a time machine and go back to racing to place in the queue early. Talk to your gamer friends - they might have gotten lucky and then gotten their EVGA notification. One friend of mine did that for another and it worked out well.

I like NVIDIA but considering Jensen knows the sky's the limit, I'd just put an entry in your calendar to eventually stalk the 4000 series launch. I'm also curious if they might consider letting people "step-up" (EVGA has nice US customer support and lets you trade-in) to 4's from 2's, but could drain supply for people insane enough to double dip upgrades during the shortage.

ZOTAC

I tried to get my friends to do a "Brotherhood of the Traveling ZOTAC" as a meme since someone got one but planned to upgrade. I think NerdSpeak knows some ZOTAC people so I was cracking jokes about it for a while. Too bad they're pretty expensive on MSRP. EVGA's top tier 3090 is US \$1889, theirs is US \$2799.

It's so expensive it's in stock on their site right now. Why get scalped when you can pay overpriced MSRP?

Other Stores

Every other site seems to be constantly out of stock. You could try Distill or another browser extension to keep tabs on sites you like. That's how I got a Dark Hero motherboard from ASUS itself. It just constantly loads the site at intervals you set, then rings an audio que.

OTHER IDEAS TO GET ONE:

PREBUILTS

Increasingly an idea, think the shuffle but worse, almost. A lot of YouTubers are taking it on themselves (Gamers Nexus is one, but a lot of small channels too) to review them due to the trend rising.

There are other advantages to prebuilts too, but you're better off having a friend do it for you in a normal market. Unless you really want a single warranty. Most of the GPUs are gonna be from the OEM unless it's a Gamer brand or a more third party option.

The DELL GPU's aren't amazing - they don't have heatsinks on the VRAM that hits 90-100C and is considered normal for the 3000 series, for one. That irks a lot of people but the cards have too small of a sample size to really tell right now.
