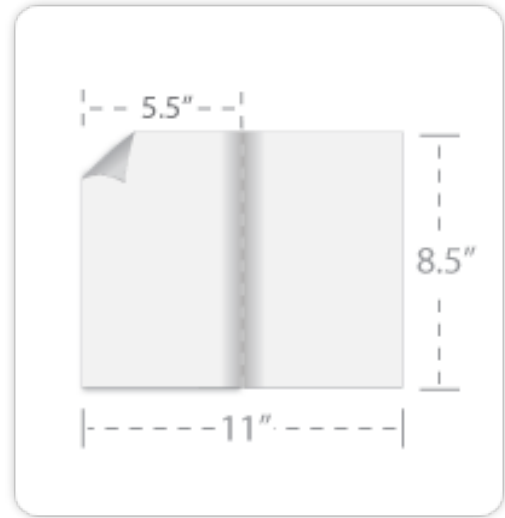


Zine Submission Requirements

Before submitting content to be included in the Fall 2020 WHUS Zine, please review the following guidelines. *If your submission does not meet these guidelines, follow the student code, or align with the values of WHUS we reserve the right to censor, alter, or not print your work.*

Size

- For single page submissions
 - Size 5.5in x 8.5in
- For full-spread submissions
 - Size 11in x 8.5in
- You can submit smaller works, just be prepared for them to share a page with other small pieces from other artists



Accepted File Formats

- .png, .jpg, .pdf, .jpeg, .RAW
- Anything from Google Suite, Microsoft Office or Adobe Suite
- Try to keep in simpler formats for ease of adapting to pages, most file formats will work but the listed are easiest to work with

Explicit Content

- Profanity, as in swears or offensive language, is allowed.
- Indecency, as in nudity, bodily functions, or sexual content, is allowed granted it does not fit the description of obscenity.
- Obscene content is **not allowed**. Obscene content would be considered both sexual and offensive to the general public, and it also lacks artistic, literary, scientific and political value as a whole. Examples would be: graphic pornographic content, underage nudity, illegal sex acts, beasiality, etc.
- Content created with the intent to harm others is **not allowed**. Examples would be: death threats, hate speech, harassment, bullying, libel, etc.
- Any content that breaks the rules outlined in [The Student Code](#) is **not allowed**. Please refer to pages 5-7 of the linked document.

Additional Requirements

- All content must be your own original work or used with the proper credit given.
- Your submission does not need to be new, you are free to submit work that was done in the past, for classes or for fun.
- You must be able to make an argument as to how your submission falls within the theme of the Zine. The theme is intentionally broad for this reason.
