## PITCHING

1. Wins – 10 – Daniel VanderKooi ('01)
2. Shutouts – 8 – Bruce Bode and Dean Douma ('65) in 12 league games;  
Note: They held opponents to a .114 batting average!
3. Earned run average – 1.17 – Mark Holleman ('03); no documentation from 1965
4. Strikeouts – 112 – Mark Holleman ('03)
5. Innings pitched – 83 – Landon VanDyk ('00)
6. No-hitters – 3 – Kevin Roosma ('98)
7. Strike percentage – 70% - Jonah Terpstra ('24)

Notable: some incredible records from outstanding pitchers like Bruce Bode and Dean Douma ('63-'65), Hank Roorda ('67-'69) and Doug Elsbree ('74-'75) are incomplete at this point.

A special note 1: in 1964 Bruce Bode threw a 1-hitter with 19 strikeouts at Mt. Baker and recalls having 115 K in 50 IP in '65

Special note 2: in 1981 Drew Roosma pitched a 14-inning shutout and beat Blaine 1-0 with an RBI hit. Special note 3: fewest pitches in a 7-inning game – 60 – Jonah Terpstra ('24)

Two standouts: for 4 years at LC the versatile Scott Romjue ('93-'96) played 100 games and produced 100 hits, scored 77 runs, and won 19 (1919) games as a pitcher to lead LC to a trifecta of league championships ('93, '94, and '95); for his 4-year career at LC the dedicated hitter Austin Engels played 95 games, and he collected 120 hits (40 ebh), scored 77 runs, and had 94 RBI with a B.A. of .433 and was accorded the 2024 and 2025 triple crown winner in Whatcom County.
