Our school's annual Ag Day is happening on Thursday 15th October. The following information is for children who will be participating in the Horticultural Happenings activities. If your child has an animal for Ag Day, the following information does not apply to them, as your child will be busy training their animal during Week 1.

It is important that your child has chosen <u>2 activities</u> from the 5 that have been listed:

Must Do: Choose at least two from this list:

Miniature Novelty Gardens (Reused or 'natural' items only) Shoebox size containers. Trays

Pebbles, moss, mirrors, figures, animals flowers, etc.

Vaseline Saucers

Saucers (named on the back) Vaseline Small flowers and leaves

Paper Vase Craft

The card will be provided for you to draw your own vase, decorate, colour and/ or paint it. A teacher will then poke holes in the cardboard where you have drawn for you to then insert your flowers through the gaps.

Paper
PVA glue (school will provide)



Aqua Jar

Stick blue-tac inside the lid - poke with a toothpick.

Arrange the flowers in the holes.

Fill the jar with plain or coloured water.

Place the flowers, attached to the inside of the lid, into the jar and screw the lid firmly into place.
