Our goals for the retreat include:

- i. **Develop our AAUW Kingston branch 2012-2013 strategic plan** and set priorities for the coming year. Some of the questions we need to address include:
 - a. Should we have both a 501(c)3 and 4?
 - b. Leadership: How well has our "Occupy Wall Street" style of leadership worked this year? What can we do to strengthen it? How can we engage more members in leading projects?
 - c. Collaboration: How can we best grow our new relationships with SUNY New Paltz and SUNY Ulster? Are there projects best accomplished through collaboration?

 What groups should we approach?
 - d. How can we recruit a more diverse membership committed to our mission? (age, ethnicity, gender, etc.)
- ii. Develop a media literacy project plan to educate junior high through college age students— females and males— building on the <u>Miss Representation</u> film and existing media literacy curriculum.
