## Course Overview:

There will be four units for this course. Each unit will end with a District Unit Assessment and TDW (Text-Dependent-Writing) prompt.

Low Grades- 10% Middle Grades- 30%

High Grades: 60%

## Thinking Task:

Students will complete a Thinking Task everyday at the start of class, and they will be collected at the end of the week for a grade. Students who choose not to complete their Thinking Task during class time will not have the opportunity to make it up. Students who are absent from class will not lose points and can contact Ms. Sturkie to make up the Thinking Task. Thinking Tasks will not be posted in Google Classroom.

- A <u>charged</u> chromebook every day

<u>Homework</u>: Students can expect to be assigned weekly homework (vocabulary, grammar, study guide, etc..).
