- 1) Get to know you questions (icebreaker) 3:00-3:20
 - a) Cut up questions onto slips of paper and put them in a cup. Everyone sits at tables with their age group and answers/asks questions to learn about each other. Volunteers help younger kids who can't read well or kids who are quiet.
- 1) Snack 3:00-3:20
- 2) Saint of the Month: St. Bernadette 3:20-3:25
- 3) Water Balloon toss outside 3:30-3:45
 - a) Place kids in 2 long lines paired with a partner. Start 2 feet apart- toss the balloon to the partner. If you drop a balloon or it pops, you are out.
 Then take a step back and toss to your partner. Continue taking a step back until 1 group left. Prize for the winning group (Dollar store candy/prize). Can redo until balloons all gone. Kids love this!

 - a) See attached list you can modify this for your school
 - b) Put kids in the same age groups or pairs depending on how many kids you have.
 - c) Each group gets the scavenger hunt list. Place a sheet of stickers at each location and the group needs to get a sticker and place it on their list to prove they were at each stop. The winner gets a prize (Dollar store prize). Ideal to have a volunteer with each group -especially the little kids.

Supplies:

- 1) Printed list of questions, cut up and put into a cup. One list for each group
- 2) Snack capri suns and popsicles
- 3) Filled Water Balloons
- 4) Scavenger hunt List -1 for each group
- 5) Dollar store
 - a) Stickers if there are 6 groups, put a sheet of 6 stickers taped to the wall at each location on the scavenger hunt.
 - b) 2-4 prizes ring pops at the dollar store are a good choice

St. Bernadette Soubirous (1844-1879) had such a difficult time learning that at age 14 she was still unable to count and hadn't yet made her First Communion because she was unable to answer the necessary catechism questions. But it was exactly this difficulty that won the confidence of Bernadette's priest when she revealed that Our Lady had appeared to her. Bernadette was unable to read and spoke a local dialect, with no knowledge of French at all. So when she declared that the Lady was "the Immaculate Conception," her priest was convinced that Bernadette couldn't have invented the story -- she simply wasn't capable of it. After the apparitions at Lourdes were over, Bernadette entered a convent, where her intellectual difficulties continued to complicate her life. At one point, her mother superior despaired of finding a job for the young sister, saying, "She is a little stupid, and is good for nothing." Bernadette was tasked with praying, which she could do quite well even without much education, and she spent the rest of her life pleasing God in the convent, whatever the other Sisters might have thought.
