- Students car was stolen from the parking lot

  - Cars in the back near the building next door are being targeted
  - Cameras outside in the parking lot do not work
- What time does the key cards stop working?
  - Card will not work after 8
- Gym equipment
  - What was actually purchased?
  - There was a survey but it seems like nothing has changed
- Fragrances on campus Perfume free
- Dogs on campus
  - Email will be sent out about dog policy from Tia or OAA
  - How to approach those with service dogs?
  - Students are allergic to animals inform cohort about having dogs sit in desks and on the couches in the lounge
