SUPPORTING THE TREASURE BEACH COMMUNITY IN THE WAKE OF HURRICANE MELISSA

Last Updated: November 24, 2025

On October 28, Hurricane Melissa made landfall in Jamaica as the strongest storm on record to ever hit the island, leaving a trail of destruction in its wake. Barely 16 months after Hurricane Beryl, our wonderful Treasure Beach has been severely impacted once again. As always, the community is rebuilding with their characteristic resilience, love and support for one another. But they need our help!

This document's aim is to compile information on some of the known ongoing fundraising efforts and ways to support, so that donation links and key information is centralized. It also recognizes that people like to give in different ways – some to larger efforts, some to businesses/individuals that they know, etc. It is thus organized as follows: 1) large-scale efforts focused specifically on the greater Treasure Beach area; 2) fundraisers for specific Treasure Beach businesses/families; 3) international charities that are running general Hurricane Melissa relief drives; 4) ways to contribute essential goods and needed items; 5) fundraising events and 6) calls for volunteers.
