Essential Outcomes:

Learning Targets:

Essential Outcomes:

Students will demonstrate the ability to apply font attributes.

Learning Targets:

I can change the size of the fonts to larger or smaller sizes.

I can change the fonts to italics, bold and underline.

I can change the color of the fonts.

Essential Outcomes:

Students will demonstrate the appropriate use of Backspace, Shift key, Delete key, Enter Key, and Space Bar.

Learning Targets:

I can use the backspace bar to delete text to the left.

I can use the delete key to delete text.

I can use the shift key to type capital letters and other alternate "upper" characters.

I can use the Enter Key to send the cursor to the next line.

I can use the Space Bar key to create an empty space
