3. Preschool Graduation

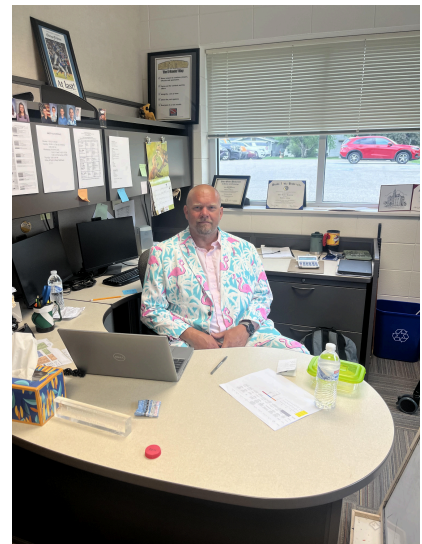
A huge thank you to our preschool staff and their aides for organizing a wonderful graduation event. It was a full house and everything ran smoothly.

Summer Tutoring Program

Our goal is to help close the achievement gap and boost student performance. This program focuses on strengthening foundational reading skills—including phonological awareness, phonics, fluency, comprehension, and vocabulary—to increase proficiency on the FAST universal screener assessments administered in the fall and spring.

Additionally, the program aims to improve ISASP reading proficiency scores and ensure appropriate academic growth for all participating students.

- Frequency: Twice per week, Duration: 1 hour per session per student
