Under this agreement, acceptance as a declared business major requires the completion of a minimum of 60 s.h. with a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.50. The student must have also completed ACCT 201 and 202, ECON 231 and 232, MATH 137, and STAT 171. Transfer students not eligible to declare will be limited to 29 hours of business coursework at WIU until these requirements have been met. Enrollment in a Pre-Business Program does not guarantee acceptance into one of the major areas as a candidate for the Bachelor of Business degree.
