## #30 Understanding The End Of The Age In Matthew 24

We have been sharing with you on end time events for sometime, we are talking about Matthew 24, Mark 13, Luke 21 presently, and it is important for you to understand this in relation to end time. We have been talking in general about end time events talking about what is going to happen during the tribulation, and the other things that are going to happen after the tribulation that we will be covering, also understanding the abomination of desolation that Daniel spoke of that has already been fulfilled in the timing when that occurred.

Matt 24:3 And as he sat upon the mount of Olives, the disciples came unto him privately, saying, Tell us, when shall these things be? (And these are the things when the temple would be destroyed) and what shall be the sign of thy coming, and of the end of the world? ("Age" So we are talking about two other things, the sign of his coming, and the end of the age)

Mark 13:3-4 And as he sat upon the mount of Olives over against the temple, Peter and James and John and Andrew (4 of them came to him) asked him privately, 4. Tell us, when shall these things be? (When the destruction of the temple would occur) and what shall be the sign when all these things shall be fulfilled? (Or shall be ending, or being fulfilled or completed. We look over in Luke 21:7 when they asked him the questions again and said)

Luke 21:7 And they asked him, saying, Master, but when shall these things be? and what sign will there be (Or what sign will be) when these things shall come (Might be coming) to pass? (Or about to be coming to pass, about to happen as Young's brings out. This is a subjunctive mood verb meaning it was a condition, conditions had to be met 1st to see these things coming to pass, and it being a present tense indicates it was going to be an ongoing action of these about to be coming to pass. This is speaking about what is going to happen during the tribulation period of the things that are brought forth. We already talked about answering one of the questions before. Remember Matthew 24:4-14 that is where the question about the end is answered. From Matthew 24:15-20 that we have already talked about that is the time when the temple was destroyed, then Matthew 24:21-51 and into Matthew 25 it talks, answers the question about his coming. We pointed out what the end is talking about, and what the coming is talking about which is important to understand. The end is talking about what will be after the ongoing work during the tribulation, they will end up with a time of when Jesus will begin to rule and to reign, we would be saved, we would come through the end time period in the tribulation. Then we talked about what the coming was, and we gave many of the scriptures showing that the coming refers to after the tribulation. This is talking about the coming, remember the coming has two aspects. 1. Is his coming for the saints that is what he comes for in the rapture catching up the church to meet the Lord in the air in fulfillment of the feast of Trumpets. 2. Then coming with the saints 10 days later, and bringing the Day of Atonement judgment that will occur. So the end

is speaking about the events during the tribulation, and then the coming is speaking about the events after the tribulation is over. We pointed out by the way in Matthew 24:21 when it speaks of the fact that after it finished what had happened the temple was destroyed, he speaks about there being great tribulation)

Matt 24:21-22 For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be. () 22. And except those days should be shortened, (And they are shortened 10 days from the reign of the anti-christ who reigns for 1,260 days from Nisan 1st month 10th day to Tishri 7th month 10th day after 3 1/2 years. It will be shortened because of the fact that it says) there should no flesh be saved: (Indicating that there is going to be such wars going on it would destroy everybody, more than likely nuclear wars will be happening all over the world) but for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened. (We also mentioned here that after the tribulation is when all this occurs with the. Why is it immediately after the tribulation? Because as soon as the tribulation is over because he shortened it, he is going to come, and catch the church up to meet the Lord in the air. And that is going to be 10 days earlier as we mentioned than the reign of the anti-christ which would be on Tishri day 1 the catching up at the church we will be talking about that in the coming video but that will not be until Sunday. Matthew 25:15 we spoke of the abomination of desolation that Daniel spoke of. What was the Abomination? It had nothing to do with a future anti-christ setting up an image to be worshiped in a so-called rebuilt temple that he would then come, and break a so-called 7 years covenant with the Jews and then break that covenant, and cut off the sacrifices that they had been offering, that is a lying teaching, and false teaching that has come forth from the body of Christ. One of the things we know is the abomination that Daniel is speaking of in Daniel 9 was the ongoing offering up over the spreading of time of the sacrifices they were being offered in the temple the Jews having rejected the sacrifice of Jesus. We know that is the case especially from the word "Stand" is an important word to understand)

Matt 24:15 When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand ("Stand" is a perfect tense verb, the perfect tense means completed action in the past with present results at the time of speaking or concerning the time of speaking which is when the destruction of the temple would occur. That meant something was completed in the past that led up to the time when the destruction of the temple heard. What was going on in the past? The sacrifices were being offered up continually which was wrong, because Jesus had caused the sacrifice, and the oblation to cease, because he was the sacrifice for sins once and for all. And because of that 40 years there was time for them to have an opportunity to repent from 30 AD to 70 AD, but they did not repent 70 AD the desolation that was determined came upon the temple, and the Jews in Jerusalem, and the place was destroyed. This is what happened in the fulfillment of this because it goes on and talks about when this was going to happen)

Matt 24:16-20 Then let them which be in Judaea flee into the mountains: (They were supposed to flee out of Judah) 17. Let him which is on the housetop not come down to take any thing out of his house: (They were not to take anything out of their house they had to get out right away) 18. Neither let him which is in the field return back to take his clothes. (They were not go back to take their clothes) 19. And woe unto them that are with child, and to them that give suck in those days! 20. But pray ye that your flight be not in the winter, neither on the sabbath day: (We pointed out the reason why it said not on the sabbath day is because the gates of the city were closed on the sabbath day, and it would be hard to get out of town it was on that particular day, and this is what they did at the time the destruction. We know it is talking about the destruction because parallel with that as we pointed out just for a moment to look at in Luke 21:20)

Luke 21:20-24 And when ye shall see Jerusalem compassed with armies, then know that the desolation thereof is nigh. (So that tells you when you see it compass with armies. When was that? That happened when the roman armies came around Jerusalem bring the construction, and to bring the desolation that was determined by God, because of their rebellion, and continuing to offer up those sacrifices) 21. Then let them which are in Judaea flee to the mountains; and let them which are in the midst of it depart out; and let not them that are in the countries enter thereinto. 22. For these be the days of vengeance, (God's vengeance against them because of rejecting the sacrifice of Jesus) that all things which are written may be fulfilled. 23. But woe unto them that are with child, and to them that give suck, in those days! for there shall be great distress (Same circumstances are brought forth) in the land, and wrath upon this people. 24. And they shall fall by the edge of the sword, and shall be led away captive into all nations: and Jerusalem shall be trodden down of the Gentiles, until the times of the Gentiles be fulfilled. (Because they were under judgment until they could become a nation again which Israel could not become a nation until 1948, and they did because of the judgment upon them, and then Jerusalem was retaken in 1967 19 years later and that judgment ended as well. Talked about understanding that and the other teaching about some anti-christ making a covenant with the Jews for 7 years is all false. Remember 69 weeks elapsed at the time of Messiah he was here for 3 1/2 years ministering, so 69 and 1/2 weeks have elapsed there is only 1/2 week left not 7 years, all of that is a lying teaching. Who began to talk the last time on the 1st part, and we are going to continue on that as we go back over in Matthew 24:4 because this is the answer to the question from verse 4 to verse 14 about the time of the end of the age. We see that this is the things that are going to happen, and we pointed out the end of the age is the tribulation leading up to the end of the age. So this is an ongoing process remember, we can see it as read through Matthew 24:4-14)

Matt 24:4 And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you. (Speak about deceiving, "Let no man might or may deceive you" it is a subjunctive mood that means you could be deceived, but if you take heed you will not be deceived, and he does not want you to be

deceived. When it says to take this is a commanding statement to us, and it is an ongoing taking heed, because it is a present tense verb. Are you and I are commanded continually to be taking might deceive us. Because what is the mark of the last days? Tremendous deception, the deception will be so great that even the elect could be deceived that is why you have to be so founded in the word, and you were not going to be moved by anything that would try to deceive you. We see here about this "No man deceiving you" would be an active voice that you might actively be deceived yourself by various means of not walking in line with the word. Is interesting over in Luke 21:8)

Luke 21:8 And he said, Take heed that ye be not deceived: (When we look at it this time it also is a subjunctive mood meaning it is a conditional statement, the voice is passive this time. So you put those two together, and you see it is talking about you might not be actively deceived, but also that you might not be passively deceived, meaning there are going to be things that are occurring the outside, and from others that are trying to deceive you. The lying signs, wonders, miracles, things that false prophets might say all kinds of things occurring from the outside that might deceive you. So you have to be on guard that you yourself are not making decisions that have caused you to be deceived, because you are not walking in line with the word. That is going to be the key you have to know the word, but also you have to be ready to not let outside influences of any kind deceive you either) for many shall come in my name, saying, I am (Not Christ but I am) *Christ*; (Christ is not there in the Greek it simply means "I am". They are going to say that they are the one, they are essentially the ones speaking for God. They are going to be liars, remember the false prophets will come, there are people that will be speaking, and declaring things speaking lies) and the time draweth near: go ye not therefore after them. (You need to stay away from them absolutely. So let's go to Matthew 24:8, deception will be the mark of the last days. You could be deceived actively yourself by not knowing the word or by others or other circumstances or occurrences that you might fall for, and believe or yield to, and you must guard yourself it is mandatory. Here he is beginning to talk about all the things that are going to happen during this tribulation period leading up to the end of the age. That are going to happen once Jesus opens up the title deed, you will see that in just a moment)

Matt 24:6-8 And ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars: see that ye be not troubled: (Or this means to be frightened, troubled in mind, or alarmed, if you know these things are going to happen, and you understand why they are going to happen then you should not be troubled or alarmed when they happen. If you do not understand you will be blown away, and that is why many people will be blown away because they do not understand. Do you have an understanding of what is going to come going into it will be important) for all these things must come to pass, (Remember this word "Must" is the Greek word "Dei" which means "Necessary or necessary as binding" it is a covenant statement or a legal statement in this case. Why is it that it must come to pass? Because of the things that are written? They are written in the deed of purchase that is

going to be open up that are all the things that must be carried out in order to bring forth the repossession of the earth by Jesus Christ. And he says all these things must it is necessary as binding, an ongoing a present tense verb it is going to be continuous) come to pass, but the end is not yet. (Again the end is not yet, it is not at this time at all. You will hear all kinds of people saying, "Oh all these wars are happening he is going to come any second". No, he is not, the end is not yet. So you were going to know, and you are not going to be deceived by any of these false teachings, and lies) 7. For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, (Which is plagues) and earthquakes, in divers places. (These things are going to happen, and this is going to happen during the tribulation period. And all these things as it said, they must come to pass, and we must understand that these are what is called the beginning of sorrows) 8. All these are the beginning of sorrows. (The word sorrows is not quite accurate in a sense, it is the Greek word "O-deen" that means "The pain of childbirth or travailing" in pain when someone is birthing a child. From a standpoint of what this means regarding the end time events this is going to mean "The intolerable anguish" because of the calamities that are going to be occurring for the judgments that are going to be poured out. Tremendous intolerable anguish is going to be happening, and this does not say it is going to be over just like that, no this is the beginning of it, it is going to be occurring over the period of time of the 3 1/2 years as all these seals are going to be opened up. Now in Mark 13:8 we want to see some of the other things that speaks of during this time)

Mark 13:8 For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be earthquakes in divers places, and there shall be famines and troubles: (This refers to "Disturbances, commotion, tumult, sedition") these are the beginnings of sorrows. (This intolerable anguish)

Luke 21:11 And great earthquakes shall be in divers places, and famines, and pestilences; (And then it adds some others things) and fearful sights (That will cause terror in people, you cannot be moved by the things that you are going to be seeing) and great signs shall there be from heaven. (And this is talking about heaven, it is not talking about the heavenlies. This is the word for heaven which is singular in the Greek, indicating this is coming from heaven. Remember the evil spirits will not be in the heavenlies then because they have already beat the cast down from the heaven and they are going to be on earth of course having great wrath knowing they have a short time. We see in Luke 21:25 it speaks more about the things that are going to be happening)

Luke 21:25-27 And there shall be signs in the sun, and in the moon, and in the stars; and upon the earth distress of nations, with perplexity; (They will not know what to do about anything) the sea and the waves roaring; (These things will also be happening) 26. Men's hearts failing them for fear, and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth: (And this is further down in the tribulation period as we are going. So this means there is going to be an intensity, an

increasing intensity of judgments that are being poured out) for the powers of heaven shall be shaken. (These are the kinds of things that are going to happen before they see the son of man coming in the cloud) 27. And then shall they see the Son of man coming in a cloud with power and great glory. (So there is going to be a tremendous shaking that is going to happen. One of the things we need to realize there will be a preaching of the gospel during this time until it reaches all nations)

Mark 13:10 And the gospel must (Necessary) first (First in time or place) be published among all nations. (It will be brought to all nations, then after that that is when they begin to bring destruction, and to lead people and persecute them, betrayal comes. We will be talking about that in a little bit. But you must realize that the gospel will be preached during the tribulation, and this is going to be a progress of going through this time)

Luke 21:9 But when ye shall hear of wars and commotions, be not terrified: for these things must first (First in time) come to pass; (Remember all these things are going to come to pass) but the end is not by and by. (Or forth with, it is not coming yet as you recall. So at the same time you must understand as we pointed out that this is the time of the opening up of the seals to bring judgment. We referred to this before but we will look at it for a moment. John was caught up to heaven to see the things that were going to be happening from heaven after the Judgment was finished on the church)

Rev 4:5 (And they speak of judgments that are going to be released. Judgments have been shown forth over time in history regarding these lightnings and these kinds of things)

1Sam 2:10 The adversaries of the LORD shall be broken to pieces; out of heaven shall he thunder upon them: (This is a revelation of what he was going to do this time, but also what he is going to do in the end) the LORD shall judge the ends of the earth; and he shall give strength unto his king, and exalt the horn of his anointed. (We also see this is the time of the end after the church age is over which means this would be in the beginning of the time of the tribulation period. Here we see in another place this is where the Israelites refused to have Samuel, and the prophets ruling over them any longer, and they were going to see judgment, and this is what Samuel said)

1Sam 12:17-18 Is it not wheat harvest to day? (Wheat refers to the church age, and the barley was the Jews, the wheat is the saints during the church age, and that would be at the end of that time) I will call unto the LORD, and he shall send thunder and rain; (Because that is what is going to follow as the judgments are coming on those who rejected his rule and reign which would be all the believers who fell away, as well as those that apostasized or abandoned him, as well as the ones who have rejected him) that ye may perceive and see that your wickedness is

great, (The judgment is going to come because of the wickedness of man) which ye have done in the sight of the LORD, in asking you a king. (In this case it was asking for a king. Of course they are going to reject Jesus's rule over them, and they are going to be ready to follow after the anti-christ rule, the who will take the mark, and will make a great mistake) 18. So Samuel called unto the LORD; and the LORD sent thunder and rain that day: and all the people greatly feared the LORD and Samuel. (This is pointing towards what is going to happen in the end. After Revelation 4 seeing the scene in heaven where the judgments were ready to be poured out by the angels carrying them out we come to Revelation 5:1 where we talked about it in the past, but we want to review this for a moment)

Rev 5:1-3 And I saw in the right hand of him that sat on the throne a book written within and on the backside, (Something that is written within and on the back side is a deed of purchase) sealed with seven seals. (There was nobody able to open it as he said) 2. And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, Who is worthy to open the book, and to loose the seals thereof? 3. And no man in heaven, nor in earth, neither under the earth, was able to open the book, neither to look thereon. (Nobody could do this, and after John was weeping about it)

Rev 5:5 And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Juda, the Root of David, hath (Conquered) prevailed (It is the Greek word "Nik-ah-o" which means he has conquered, and carried of the victory) to open the book, (Only the one who had done that could be able to open the book because he is the one who accomplished the redemption. Remember he had the right of redemption, right of inheritance, and he became the heir. He brought forth a New Covenant, and he accomplished destroying the works of the enemy) and to loose the seven seals thereof. (He is the one that redeemed us, it says that in verse 9)

Rev 5:9 And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy (He was worthy) to take the book, (Which is this title deed) and to open the seals thereof: (Which is necessary to bring the judgments to take back the possession up earth) for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God (That was one of the prerequisites which he had to fulfill to be able to do this to accomplish the redemption which he did) by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation; (That was one of the prerequisites which he had to fulfill to be able to do this to accomplish the redemption which he did. We also have referred to this in the past but knowing what these seals are on the inside written about, and what they are pointing towards as well as what we see in Revelation which was already declared in Ezekiel 2:9-10)

Ezk 2:9-10 And when I looked, behold, an hand was sent unto me; and, lo, a roll of a book was therein; (Was given to him) 10. And he spread it before me; and it was written within and without: (That is a deed purchase) and there was written therein (That is on the inside) lamentations, and mourning, and woe. (That is all the effects of the judgments that are going to

be poured out, and what is going to happen. The tremendous lamentations, and mourning, and woe is going to be released, and what is going to happen to the people. So having seen that he is the one who is able to open this up remember the first thing that happens, and this would be at the end of the lease of 6,000 years being finished, now Jesus will have the right as he has the right of redemption, and the right of inheritance, he is the heir, he has accomplished, he prevailed, and he did everything that was necessary meeting all the conditions, and now he is going to open up these seals)

Rev 6:1-2 And I saw when the Lamb opened one of the seals, and I heard, as it were the noise of thunder, one of the four beasts saying, (The noise of the thunder remember that means the judgments are going to be released, and the war is going to be commenced in order to accomplish everything that needs to be done because there had to be some conquering) Come and see. 2. And I saw, and behold a white horse: (And when Jesus is on the horse what is he doing? He is conquering, and remember he is going to come back in Revelation 19 conquering) and he that sat on him had a bow; (This is the bow for launching arrows destruction against the enemies) and a crown was given unto him: (This is the Greek word "Stef-an-os" meaning "Crown" which is the crown that is given to the victor, the prize to the victor he is the one who conquered, and he is the one who has gained the victory, he is the one who has this crown of victory. What did he do? What is the first thing that Jesus is going to do as he is opening the seals?) and he went forth conquering, and to conquer. (And what is this conquering? We say why he already conquered. What is this conquering? This is a different conquering, this is the same Greek word "Nik-ah-o" meaning "To conquer, and carry off the victory" and this is in the present tense meaning this will be an ongoing action until it gets completed which will be rather quickly. Who carries out the work? It is the angels that are going to go into operation as the warfare commences, and we see this in Revelation 12:7)

Rev 12:7-9 And there was war in heaven: Michael and his angels fought against the dragon; and the dragon fought and his angels. (The war will go on, this is heaven which is singular because satan has access to heaven, he was accusing us of our sins night, and day. At the same time after the lease is over who is going to be in control of everything, the battle is on? Of course satan realizes that he has to fight to try to win, he already lost the battle before when he thought he killed Jesus, he thought he was killing the heir, and he would have the right to the inheritance of the earth, but of course it was the opposite because Jesus had to go through that in order to die in order to get to him that had the power of death, and accomplish the redemption bringing forth the reconciliation by being born from spiritual death to spiritual life. Then as a newborn person going up and bringing him out of hell taking back the keys of hell, then going up to heaven, and pouring out his blood on the mercy seat, and appearing before God on our behalf having accomplished eternal redemption for us, he had to do all things which he did) Michael and his angels fought against the dragon; and the dragon fought and his angels. (The war will come, and

be occurring right away on Nisan day 1) 8. And prevailed not; (And they will not be able to conquer) neither was their place found any more in heaven. (Because they will be cast out) 9. And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: (He has been deceiving continually the entire inhabited earth, it is not world, not cosmos, but the inhabited earth, and he has been doing it all along. The deception has deceived the multitudes over all these thousands of years) he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him. (And remember as it says down here in Revelations 12:12)

Rev 12:12 Therefore rejoice, ye heavens, and ye that dwell in them. Woe to the inhabiters of the earth (Those who are on earth) and of the sea! for the devil is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knoweth that he hath but a short time. (He knows he has been kicked out, he has been defeated in heaven, and he knows now that he has a short time before it is going to be all over for him, and he is not going to be operating, he is going to be in the bottomless pit on Tishri day 10 after 3 1/2 years he knows what is coming to him. So Jesus is bringing for this conquering in order to conquer satan, and all these evil spirits which occurs, then he says...)

Rev 6:2-8 And I saw, and behold a white horse; and he that sat on him had a bow; and a crown was given unto him: and he went forth conquering, (And then it says) and to (It is not the word "To") conquer. (This is a "Hin-ah" clause in the Greek which means "In order that" and the word "Conquer" not to conquer is an infinitive "In order that he might conquer" which is a subjunctive mood, meaning this was a conditional statement here. In other words what was the condition? He had to do this first, conquering. He had to conquer satan, and all the evil spirits, and cast them down out of heaven first to clean house, and then that he might conquer. And where is this conquering occurring? On the earth, now he is going to bring the judgment upon the nations, and all of these) 3. And when he had opened the second seal, I heard the second beast say, Come and see. (And we already saw what is the first thing? Nation would rise against nation, kingdom against kingdom there would be wars and rumors of wars, and all these things exactly what we see here) 4. And there went out another horse that was red: and power was given to him that sat thereon to take peace from the earth, and that they should kill one another: and there was given unto him a great sword. (This is wars that are bringing destruction of the nations that have rebelled against him. There will be wars, and nations will be rising up, they will be stirred up against each other, and there will be wars that are going to continually occur, and that of course is part of it. We also saw their talk about famines too) 5. And when he had opened the third seal, I heard the third beast say, Come and see. And I beheld, and lo a black horse; and he that sat on him had a pair of balances in his hand. 6. And I heard a voice in the midst of the four beasts say, A measure of wheat for a penny, and three measures of barley for a penny; and see thou hurt not the oil and the wine. (This is referring to the fact of a financial upheaval because this is what it will take for just being able to have enough money for a day's food, and it shows you that there is going to be a tremendous financial upheaval that is coming, and there will come for some. At the

same time God will be providing for all those that are walking in his ways. Remember he has the silver, he can and he will provide for us) 7. And when he had opened the fourth seal, I heard the voice of the fourth beast say, Come and see. 8. And I looked, and behold a pale horse: and his name that sat on him was Death, and Hell (This is the increasing destruction of the judgments that are coming) followed with him. And power was given unto them over the fourth part of the earth, (A fourth part of the earth is being destroyed and the people) to kill with sword, and with hunger, (That is famines) and with death, and with the beasts of the earth. (The beast of the earth are going to be used as well to bring forth God's judgments, and destruction is going to be coming continually. We see these things are going to be happening, and we come back over to Mark 13 the reason we show this is because of what is happening in the opening of the seals is exactly what is happening here. So when is Matthew 24, Mark 13, and Luke 21 occurring? During the tribulation as the seals are being opened, and the judgments are being released)

Mark 13:8 For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be earthquakes in divers places, and there shall be famines and troubles: these are the beginnings of sorrows. (All the things, everything is this upheaval, and remember this is an ongoing process, because the beginnings of the sorrows the "Intolerable anguish" is going to be released. Tremendous things are going to be happening, and remember what we saw in Luke 21:10)

Luke 21:10-11 Then said he until them, Nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: 11. And great earthquakes shall be in divers places, and famines, and pestilences; (The same thing, these are all the judgments that are being released) and fearful sights and great signs shall there be from heaven. (You know God's purpose in bringing judgment is to bring repentance. It talks about how people when the judgments come they still will not repent. God wants people to repent and to turn to him. These judgments are the divine retribution or the recompense or the paying back, the repaying against all those who have done evil things. God repays, what you sow you are going to reap, you put out such and such it is going to come back upon you. So it is going to be wars, famines, plagues, all these different things. Troubles, and commotion of all types, calamities, distresses, all types of tremendous sufferings, agonies, and intolerable anguish is going to be coming upon the entire world. They are being judged as God is taking back the rule of the earth. Also we see in Matthew 24:9 this will be a process little by little over time. Remember it is not just all of a sudden and that's it, it is going to be continually over this 3 1/2 years period, and the seals opened up are the long end of the things that happened. We do not see the exact time but we know that when we come to the 5th seal where the saints are being killed then the 6th seal open up with a great earthquake, that is right before the coming of Jesus. So it is really giving you the long picture of what is going to happen during that whole 3 1/2 year period. So here we see after this it talks about the beginning of the people being afflicted)

Matt 24:9 Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall kill you: and ye shall be hated of all nations for my name's sake. ((This is not going to happen right away, and the reason we say this if we go back to Revelation 6:9. We saw the 4th seal and all the death coming, now here is the 5th seal)

Rev 6:9 And when he had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held: (This will be down the line, there will be the killing of Christians as they will be rising up of the evil people who will not repent, and will not get right. They will hate the Christians and they will blame them for everything, you can see that anti-christ spirit already operating in the world even now, and of course it is going to be very strong when the anti-christ is ruling for the 1,260 days)

Matt 24:9-10 Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall kill you: and ye shall be hated of all nations for my name's sake. 10. And then shall many be offended, and shall betray one another, and shall hate one another. (So the Betrayal will be occurring at the same time, and it is important that we understand that this betrayal that is going to happen, it can happen from anybody who would not be right with God)

Luke 21:11-16 And great earthquakes shall be in divers places, and famines, and pestilences; and fearful sights and great signs shall there be from heaven. 12. But before all these, they shall lay their hands on you, and persecute you, delivering you up to the synagogues, and into prisons, being brought before kings and rulers for my name's sake. 13. And it shall turn to you for a testimony. 14. Settle it therefore in your hearts, not to meditate before what ye shall answer: 15. For I will give you a mouth and wisdom, which all your adversaries shall not be able to gainsay nor resist. (Then it talks about the betrayal as well) 16. And ye shall be betrayed both by parents, and brethren, and kinsfolks, and friends; (That means if someone it's not right with God you are not going to be around them or you could be betrayed. Just because they are natural family does not mean they are going to be people that you are going to be around. We are not going to be around any natural family that is not right with God whatsoever) and some of you shall they cause to be put to death. (Because if they are not right the devil will work and the parents, the brethren, kinfolks, and even friends which are not real friends. So you have got to make sure that people are right with God that you are going to be with, otherwise you do not want to be them forever. Let's go back to Matthew 24:9-12)

Matt 24:9-12 Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall kill you: and ye shall be hated of all nations for my name's sake. 10. And then shall many be offended, and shall betray one another, and shall hate one another. 11. And many false prophets shall rise, and shall deceive many. (This is during this time. There is going to be many false prophets that will rise during this time who have rejected the way of the Lord, and they are going to have a demonic anointing

upon them of false prophets speaking things, they are going to be deceiving many. That is why we tell you do not follow prophets, do not follow anybody that speaks contrary to the word. We already saw the false prophets in the past throughout the Old Testament, and we have false prophets in these days. You do not want to follow any false prophets or false teachers or false apostles, or false brethren, none any of them whatsoever. And you have to identify them so you stay away from them. You know they tried those who said they are Apostles and found they were liars, you do not want to follow anybody that says they are such and such. How are you going to know them? By their fruit, by their works, by what they say, and what they are walking after, that is how you are going to know them. And notice) and shall deceive many. (And what else is going to happen?) 12. And because iniquity (Meaning "Lawlessness" is going to come. Because lawlessness) shall abound, (This is the Greek word "An-om-ee-ah" meaning "Lawlessness") the love of many shall wax cold. (This is the Greek word for love "Ag-ah-pay" so this is talking about people who are believers which will be here during this time, and their love and not just a few but many. Because why? They are being affected by the lawlessness. What a mistake! You cannot let yourself be affected by a lawlessness. Why will that be? Because the anti-christ is going to be bringing that forth because he is actually called the "Lawless One")

2Thess 2:8 And then shall that Wicked (It is not the word "Wicked" it is the Greek word "An-om-os" meaning the "Lawless One". He is the lawless one, and he will speak against everything that is of God. He will promote lawlessness contrary to the word of God) be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming: (And also he will be bringing forth things of unrighteousness. Lawlessness, you can do anything you want you do not have to submit to any law)

2Thess 2:10 And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness (You can do anything you want there is not going to be any standard of righteousness that he will be bringing forth. So the lawlessness, and unrighteousness is what is going to manifest. If you are not committed to walk in line with the word of God, what would happen? You could easily be one of the many who are going to have their love waxed cold. What Love is the love for God and how is the love of God shown? By you loving the truth, word of God and doing the word, and walking in all his ways. So the love of many will wax cold, because of lawlessness. Well what is lawlessness? We will look at a few scriptures here for a moment that will identify a lawlessness. Anything that is sin is lawlessness)

1John 3:4 And every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure. 4. Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: (Which is the Greek word "An-om-ee-ah" meaning "Lawlessness" literally) also (He doth do is literally what it says in the Greek) the law: for sin is (When it says) the transgression of the law. (It is one Greek word which is "An-om-ee-ah" meaning "Sin is the lawlessnes". So you have to conquer all sin, if you have sin

you have lawlessness, you have a lawlessness you are going to be if that is abounding, and you let that start operating in your life your love for God will wax cold, going down. That is why we tell you to conquer all sin, and remember you are not a sinner any longer, because you do not have a sinner's spirit that you are always going to sin. That is one of the biggest lying doctrines in the body of Christ, saved by grace, and still a sinner that is a lie. You have a spirit that is righteous, and sin has no dominion over you, you are to conquer all sin, and eliminate it in your life, if you have sin you have lawlessness, and you will be in trouble. Also you have to be a doer of the word)

Matt 7:21-23 Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth (Doing a present tense) the will of my Father which is in heaven. (Those who are not continually doing the will of the Father they are going to be doing something else. They will be doing lawlessness, and they will be doing sin. Notice this is going to affect a lot of people because it says) 22. Many (Now we have many not a few) will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name (These were Christians who were born again, and who had gifts of the Holy Spirit of prophecy operating in them) have cast out devils? (They understood their authority, and they were casting out devils, just because you cast out demons does not mean you are always going to be right with God. That is important to do, but you have to deal with all the sin, and walk right, and not give place to anything else) and in thy name done many wonderful works? (Because you prophesied or you cast out demons or did many wonderful works does that mean everything is going to be fine for you just because of the actions of the past? No, it is what you do continually that counts, because remember God knows you by what you continually walk after) 23. And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: (Remember this is talking about him never knowing them. Why? Because he knows you by what you are walking after continually at any point in time ongoingly. Evidence by) depart from me, (Why? You who are working a present tense lawlessness "An-om-ee-ah". Anybody who is turning away from the word of God, and working lawlessness God will not know you, he will tell you) depart from me, ye that work iniquity. (You will be one of those who would be waxing cold, and you cannot let that happen whatsoever, lawlessness cannot be in your life)

Matt 13:41 The Son of man shall send forth his angels, and they shall gather out of his kingdom all things that offend, (Those are ones that are stumbling) and them which do iniquity; (Are doing lawlessness "An-om-ee-ah". They are going to be through, they are going to be cast into the furnace of fire. You cannot have lawlessness in your life whatsoever. And lawlessness also is revealed by what is in your heart, your heart has to be right. God wants you to have a perfect heart)

Matt 23:28 Even so ye also outwardly appear righteous unto men, (Anybody can appear righteous to men, they can be nice guys, everything around. But what are they really like though?) but within ye are full of hypocrisy and iniquity. ("An-om-ee-ah" lawlessness. We cannot have lawlessness. Where? In the heart! That is the guy who portrays himself one way but then on the inside of him he is a different way, that is a hypocrite, and hypocrites end up in the Lake of Fire, they are not saved, and the ones with lawlessness the same thing. Lawlessness is also something you can yield your members to. This is why you have to watch what you are yielding yourself to)

Rom 6:19 I speak after the manner of men because of the infirmity of your flesh: for as ye have yielded your members servants to uncleanness and to iniquity (Lawlessness "An-om-ee-ah") unto (Resulting in) iniquity; (Lawlessness meaning it is going to increase lawlessness in your life that is why you cannot yield your members to anything that is not of God. That is your mind, your words, your ears what you hear, your eyes what you see, what you are putting your hands to, who you are involved with, you cannot have fellowship with those people that are walking contrary to word) even so now yield your members servants to righteousness unto holiness. (You only want to be around things that are righteous. Remember we are set the boundaries, and touch not the unclean thing then he says I will receive you. We all see in Corinthians but you cannot have fellowship with hope that are not walking right because it will affect you. People that will not take a stand against having fellowship with people that are not right that will not take that stand they are going to be in trouble evidence by this in second Corinthians 6:14)

2Cor 6:14 Be ye not unequally yoked together (It brings a yoking of you, and this means "To have fellowship with one who is not an equal". That does not mean just about them being born again. Who essentially is an equal? Someone who is born again, and walking in line with the word, and has God first place the word of God, he is following Jesus, he is following the word of God first place, that is one that is right with God) with unbelievers: (So you were not to be yoked together with any unbelievers, really this is the Greek word "Ap-is-tos" which means "The unfaithful ones" because remember only the faithful ones the ones that are coming back with him. I am not going to be around someone who is not faithful, and you cannot be) for what fellowship hath righteousness (Which is what you are to be walking in line with not) with unrighteousness? ("An-om-ee-ah" lawlessness) and what communion hath light with darkness? (You cannot have fellowship with them you will be contaminated. And remember this does lead up to 2 Corinthians 6:17)

2Cor 6:17 Wherefore come out from among them, (That is a command for us to come out from among them, that is not a suggestion for you to think about whatever you decide you want to do. No, we are not doing what we want, we are totally submitted to him, yielded to him, we put him first place and we do what he says) come out from among them, and be ye separate, (Separate

meaning "Mark off from others by boundaries", and again this is another command. You cannot compromise you have to make the decision you are going to walk in line with his ways) saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you, (We cannot have any of the uncleanness in our life. Also you are going to have to protect yourself from that which is evil trying to come at you. Remember it can have an adverse effect upon you)

2Pet 2:7-8 And delivered just Lot, vexed with the filthy conversation (Matter of life and conduct) of the wicked: (Meaning "One who had broke through the restraint of law and gratifying his lusts". They were not walking according to law, when the lawless one comes it will be whatever you want to do in the flesh go ahead, have a party you know, that is destruction) 8. For that righteous man dwelling among them, in seeing (You do not want to even see this) and hearing, (You do not want to be in its earshot) vexed his righteous soul from day to day with their (What? The Greek word is "An-om-os" meaning) unlawful (Works or) deeds; (The Greek word "Er-gon" meaning "Works or deeds". So you do not want to be around those people because it will have an effect upon you, need to guard yourself, and that is important. Remember just because you might be right at one point of time does not mean that you might always stay in that way, because we are told to guard ourselves)

2Pet 3:17 Ye therefore, beloved, seeing ye know these things before, beware (Which is not beware it is the Greek word "Foo-las-so" meaning "To guard" and this is talking about you guarding your self it is a middle voice "For your own benefit" ongoingly it is a present tense continually, it is an imperative mood a command. You and I are to be continually guarding ourself for our benefit) lest ye also, (Remember do not think the guy says I could never fall take heed blessed you fall, everybody has to guard himself) being led away with the error of the wicked, (What is this error of the wicked? The same thing that we just saw talking about Lot, "One who had broke through the restraint of law and gratifying his lusts" which is all the people who are going to be listening or affected by the lawlessness that will come forth from the anti-christ rule. It will be prevalent everywhere, you think there are problems out in the world now it is nothing compared to what it is going to be like) fall from your own stedfastness. (No, we are not going to fall from our steadfastness we have to be steadfast, firm, constant, set upon the word of God. Lawlessness will try to work against you, in fact that is why we have to walk in line with the word of God at all times in our life. Let's go back over to Matthew 24:12-14, saw the lawlessness and it is going to be strong, it will be abounding remember)

Matt 24:12-14 And because iniquity (Lawlessness) shall abound, (Abounding, increasing, multiplying in every place, and the people that want to proclaim their values and their beliefs now multiply that about a thousand times or so. It is going to be real, they will be proclaiming what they believe everywhere) the love of many shall wax cold. 13. But he that shall endure (Or remain constant) unto the end, (So this means you are going to have to "Hoop-om-en-o" the

Greek word meaning "To remain steadfast" on the word, only those who are steadfast are going to come through, and the same the one who is steadfast) the same shall be saved. (So if you are going to be saved you have to be steadfast, you have to be committed if you are going to walk in line with the word, and that is it) 14. And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come. (It is going to be preached in all the world for a witness. One of the things you have to realize there will come a time as we are getting down to the end you probably will not be able to preach the gospel, because John 9:4 says)

John 9:4 I must work the works of him that sent me, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work. (When the total darkness has come and they are hating you, and trying to kill you at the end probably down the road of the tribulation. It is not going to happen at the beginning but it will be down the road, and all the persecution, the betrayal, and all these things happening you will not be able to do a lot, but you will be doing it first for a while, and preaching the gospel to reach all these people. We must be steadfast, it is mandatory as we saw, if you are not steadfast you are going to be in trouble. You will be hated of all men, in Matthew 10:22 it also speaks of this)

Matt 10:22 And ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake: but he that endureth (Or remain steadfast) to the end shall be saved. (You have to be steadfast on the word of God, and you cannot be a compromiser or you will go down)

2Tim 2:12 If we suffer, (Endure, remain "Hoop-om-en-o" steadfast) we shall also reign with him: (Only the steadfast ones are going to be given the signet ring, the authority to reign) if we deny him, (You deny him if you do not walk in line with the word) he also will deny us: (He is going to treat us as we would treat him. We must be steadfast it is mandatory. This is why getting the word in you is how it will happen. People say, "How am I going to get steadfast" because of God's word it will do that work in you, it will bring you to that place. Think about the areas where you are steadfast already, nothing can shake you, well that is the way you are to get everything. Nothing shakes you, you have no compromise, you have nothing that the enemy is going to be able to find anything in you because you are going to walk in the ways of the Lord, and that is how you are going to be protected)

Heb 10:32-34 But call to remembrance the former days, in which, after ye were illuminated, (When you got light) ye endured a great fight of afflictions; (You will be engaging in the warfare, you will not be engaged in the warfare in the heavenlies during the tribulation, because the demons will not be there, but you will be engaged in the warfare in the earth, because all the demons will be here you are going to be binding, loosing, resisting, and praying for angels to have charge over you to keep you and protect you. You have to walk in your authority, in

dominion the authority of the name of Jesus which continues through the tribulation, it does not just quit because the anti-christ comes on the scene, you have authority over all the works of the enemy) ye endured a great fight of afflictions; (And there will be those kinds of things that you will be fighting, and even if they come and steal all your goods look what it says) 33. Partly, whilst ye were made a gazingstock both by reproaches and afflictions; and partly, whilst ye became companions of them that were so used. 34. For ye had compassion of me in my bonds, and took joyfully the spoiling of your goods, (They come and steal, and take everything from you, do not get bent out of shape) knowing in yourselves that ye have in heaven a better and an enduring substance. (This is not your home, all the things that God has for you is what counts. If that happens to you do not be moved joyfully, do not let the joy go from you)

Heb 12:2-3 Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God. (Jesus maintained joy in the midst of everything that came at him, because he knew where he was headed) 3. For consider him that endured such contradiction (Or opposition, rebellion) of sinners against himself, (There will be tremendous opposition) lest ye be wearied and faint in your minds. ("Soul" the Greek word is "Psoo-khay". We cannot get faint in our soul. How is your soul going to be so you will not be faint? Because it is going to be steadfast on the word, the word in your mind, the word established in you that you are going to walk in all his ways, you are going to be steadfast. Remember over in James 1:12 who is going to get this crown of life?)

James 1:12 Blessed is the man that endureth temptation: (Or whatever comes at him, because remember not) for when he is tried, ("Because becoming approved" literally it says in the Greek, remember here is the two words "Dok-ee-mos" which means "Accepted or approved" and here is the Greek word "Ghin-om-ahee" meaning "To become" approved. Well, how are you going to be approved? Because you are not going to fall for any temptation, you are going to do the word) he shall receive ("Lam-ban-o" meaning "To takae hold of") the crown of life, (Is that automatic? No) which the Lord hath promised (To who?) to them that love him. (It is a promise. Do you realize every promise if you do not meet the conditions? No you have to meet the conditions, it is to those that love him. Who is the one that loves him? The one who keeps his commandments, and walks in all his ways, and is obedient. You must walk in line with the word regardless of what comes. Remember Job? Job was a perfect man it said)

James 5:11 Behold, we count them happy which endure. Ye have heard of the patience of Job, and have seen the end of the Lord; that the Lord is very pitiful, and of tender mercy. (He came through, remember Job everybody came against him)

Job 1:1 There was a man in the land of Uz, whose name was Job; and that man was perfect and upright, and one that feared God, and eschewed (Turn aside from) evil. (That is what you and I are going to do. We are going on to perfection, we are going to be upright in heart which is mandatory, and we are going to walk in the fear of God all the time, and we are absolutely going to turn away from all evil in your life, it has to be eliminated totally. Now in the midst of the suffering that you may experience, you are not going to retaliate)

1Pet 2:20 For what glory is it, if, when ye be buffeted for your faults, ye shall take it patiently? but if, when ye do well, (You have not even deserved anything) and suffer for it, ye take it patiently, (Steadfastly) this is acceptable with God. (Do not get in the retaliatory mode or you are going to go down fast. You are going to walk in the way of the Lord, and be serving him, and carrying out the things that he wants you to do. The gospel is going to be preached to remember, but there is going to come a time when there will be such tremendous persecution coming. You must understand the ones who are in control as you have heard me talk about, the government's, of business of these large corporations with positions in government all over the world are the ones that have rebelled against God, and most all of them are Ashkenazi Jews, and these people are going to be running all the evil things that are going on in the world)

Luke 21:12 But before all these, they shall lay their hands on you, and persecute you, delivering you up to the synagogues, and into prisons, being brought before kings and rulers (What was it about the synagogues? Well, the synagogues were not just a place where they would meet, and hear the word of God. The reason is because as it says here the synagogues were used for "Trials, and inflicting punishment" they would do evil things. In fact it is interesting when you look at this word and we go over here in the UBS Greek lexicon it says, "These or places that were used for judicial proceedings". They would do evil things, and even Thayer's Greek lexicon points out "The synagogue seem to date their origin from the Babylonian exile" not from Jerusalem, and the Jews would "Hold trials and even inflicted punishments in them" and that is evident from passages of scripture. Matthew 10:17 look at all the things that happened)

Matt 10:17 But beware of men: for they will deliver you up to the councils, and they will scourge you in their synagogues. (These are all the things they did)

Matt 23:34 Wherefore, behold, I send unto you prophets, and wise men, and scribes: and some of them ye shall kill and crucify; and some of them shall ye scourge in your synagogues, and persecute them from city to city: (And what do we see in Mark 13:9?)

Mark 13:9 But take heed to yourselves: for they shall deliver you up to councils; and in the synagogues ye shall be beaten: and ye shall be brought before rulers and kings (Well, they must

be the ones that are running the show, and these are the bad guys that say they are Jews but they are not. Remember they are of the synagogue of satan is what it says in Revelation 2:9)

Rev 2:9 ....I know the blasphemy of them which say they are Jews, and are not, but are the synagogue of Satan. (That is what they are. Look what happened in the book of Acts 22:19)

Acts 22:19 And I said, Lord, they know that I imprisoned and beat in every synagogue them that believed on thee: (That is what Paul did he was imprisoning and beating then in the synagogues when he kept going after the Christians before he was converted. That is where he was doing all this evil, this is what was being carried out. If you think this just cannot be true, yes it is the scripture confirms it all)

Acts 26:11 And I punished them oft in every synagogue, and compelled them to blaspheme; (This is what they are going to try to do to you or other people that might be affected. God will cause you to escape if you are counted worthy to escape all these things) and being exceedingly mad against them, I persecuted them even unto strange cities. (What you see that Paul was doing that is what the people are going to be doing, they are going to be persecuting the believers. How am I going to be protected? You are going to be right with God. Those who are righteous, those who are meek, those who are humble, those who are right with him, those that do not have any lawlessness in them those are the ones that can be protected in the last days. The deception is so great you must understand as we saw many are deceived, and it tells us in fact he warned us, and said that you are to guard yourself so you might not be deceived. You have to guard yourself, you have to be established in the word of God. So we have seen the things that are going to happen during this time, the wars and the rumors of wars, the famines, the pestilence, the fearful sights, the great signs from heaven, the earthquakes, all the disturbances. We are told do not be troubled they are all going to come to pass. Remember these are the beginning of intolerable anguish, it is not going to happen, and then it is going to be over just like that. You are in for the long haul for 3 1/2 years of these kinds of things, and remember the anti-christ will come on the scene in Nisan day 10, the 1st month day 10. Remember we saw the 1,290 days in Daniel from the day the sacrifice was taken away by Nisan day 15 because it was finished on Nisan 14 when he was the sacrifice until the setting up of that abomination which was the idol that people were to worship. It was 1,290 days on the Hebrew calendar which came to the 8th month 15th day, we saw that where Jeroboam set up the idols of the golden calves. He said it up in two places, one in Bethel, and the other in Dan. Bethel means "The house of God", Dan means "Judge". Anybody who has these things in the church are going to be judged big time, the idols are going to be set up, but that is 7 years down the road it is not going to happen immediately, it is going to be a process as these things are. Some things we see the time other things we do not know the time for sure, but it will be a process over time. That is why you have to be walking right at all times,

and make sure you are meeting all the conditions. Certainly Revelation 14:12 is something you must take heed to, and here is the steadfastness remember we the saints have to be steadfast)

Rev 14:12 Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep (Are keeping a present tense continually) the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus. (By what you are doing, because God knows what you are doing continually by your fruit, and by your works all these things. Also you have to be guarding your garments, you have to have the garments of God on)

Rev 16:15 Behold, I come as a thief. (When he comes suddenly) Blessed is he that watcheth, (Is watching, this is the one who is watching, they are giving strict attention to being cautious, and watching that they are not going to be falling into anything, you are going to have to be on guard. It is a present tense meaning continually) and keepeth his garments, (You are making sure that everything you put on stays on continually meaning there is no backsliding, there is no turning aside into the flesh or out in the world or yielding to the lawlessness or the unrighteousness for a bit, you are in trouble then, your protection will be out the window, and the angels will have charge over those who meet the conditions) lest he walk naked, (Because if you are not clothed, now you are an open Door. In fact for a moment before we finish this what happens if you are naked? Is God going to be on your side protecting you? No way) and they see his shame. (Remember in Deuteronomy 23:14)

Deut 23:14 For the LORD thy God walketh in the midst of thy camp, to deliver thee, and to give up thine enemies before thee; therefore shall thy camp (A type of the church) be holy: (Only the holy ones are going to come through) that he see no (Nakedness) unclean (Unclean really means "Nakedness". Well, you are naked it is because you are not clothed. If you are not clothed you are spiritually naked) thing in thee, (What will he do if he sees that, is he going to protect you? No, it is going to) and turn away from thee. (Guess what? The enemies of course they are going to be able to see you, because you will not have the spiritual protection that is why it says)

Rev 16:15 Behold, I come as a thief. Blessed is he that watcheth, That is watching) and keepeth (That is keeping) his garments, lest he (Might) walk naked, (A a subjunctive mood, a present tense, continuously if he has met the conditions to do what needs to be done) and they (Who are they? The bad guys who are going to be after but Christians trying to kill them) see his shame. (I will see, and they will be able to get to you because the open door will be there. He will only be protected if you meet the conditions. Those angels have charge over you to keep you in all your ways, because all the conditions have been met in Psalms 91. You are walking in the ways of the Lord. So if you will walk in his ways God will protect you. There will be persecutions, it will come to the place where Christians will be hated by all nations. We want to be one of those that are the weak nations that are going to be saved, but there will be leaders of the nations that are going to hate you. The ones who are the Babylonian Jews who rebelled against God they hate the

Christians they hate them now, and their hatred will be intensified for sure. You will be killed, you cannot let yourself be betrayed, you will be betrayed if you are around the wrong kind of people, to be wise. There will be many that will be martyred but there will be many that will come through. False prophets will rise and deceive many, the lawlessness abounding will cause the love of many to wax cold, but if you are steadfast you will possess your souls. We did not look at that scripture but this is in Luke 21:17 where we have seen this scripture many times before)

Luke 21:17-19 And ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake. 18. But there shall not an hair of your head perish. 19. In your patience (The Greek word is "Hoop-om-on-ay" meaning "Steadfastness") possess ye your souls. (That is going to be the key, this is the Greek word "Psoo-khay" meaning "Soul". If you possess your souls you are not going to give place to anything so the enemy would have placed in your life. We must make sure that we are walking in his ways, and we are going to endure to the end. Enduring to the end is when Jesus comes to catch up the church to meet the Lord in the air. That is why at the time when the end is, it is during the tribulation up to the time when we are going to be taken up by the Lord in the rapture up to meet him in the air. We know this because Matthew 24:13)

Matt 24:13-14 But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved. (Those are the ones that are going to make it) 14. And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come. (It is going to happen, and we must understand what is ahead. When you understand you will not be moved, if you do not understand you will be blown away. All the people out there that do not understand these things they are going to be blown away when they see all these things. Remember men's hearts are going to be failing them for fear about the things coming upon the earth. It is going to be so astounding they cannot even fathom what is going to be like, and the pressure would be the greatest pressure but there has ever been since the world was founded, but you are going to stay at peace. Scriptures do not change "Thou will keep them in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on thee". You are going to keep a rejoicing spirit, "Rejoice in the Lord always" that is it. You were going to be walking in the fear of the Lord always, you are going to have the fruit of the Spirit always you are going to be operating in authority always, you are going to be holy and righteous always. We will close with this last scripture which shows who is going to make it to the end, and who is going to be caught up to meet the Lord)

Eph 5:26 That he might sanctify (That is if they meet the conditions, this is what he wants to do for everybody but you have to meet the conditions to be sanctified and holy) and (Having) cleanse it (Initially) with (What? with) the washing (With the bathing, this is the new birth remember, the bathing is the regeneration) of water by the (Spoken) word, (When it talks about this it is a participle. Literally it means as Young's says, YLT "That he might sanctify it having

cleansed it with the bathing of the water in the saying". Is what happened when they were born again, that is a new birth. The cleansing was in the bathing which is the Greek word "Loo-tron" meaning "Bathing" if you have not seen this in the past in Titus 3:5)

Titus 3:5 Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, (How? By the "Loo-tron" look below, of what? The new birth. So what is the Lootron, what is the bathing? The new birth, How did it happen? Because of the washing of the water of the word the saying that came to you, and you heard the word you responded to it) by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost; (So if we go back to Ephesians 5:26)

Eph 5:26-27 That he might sanctify and cleanse (Having cleansed) it with the washing (Bathing) of water by the word, (Because he has been born again, the sanctification is conditional because that is for you to come to the place of being purified, holy before him) 27. That he might present it (Notice that is a conditional statement, it has to be done for him to be able to meet the conditions to present it. He is doing the work and all those who will let him have his way) to himself a glorious church, (That is why you have to be a part of the glorious church, if you are not part of the glorious church you are not going to be with him. Notice he is going to present to himself the glorious church. Who is going to have the glory of God? Only the holy righteous ones who are purified and cleansed. If you want to be in the rapture you have to be part of the glorious church or you will not be there. It is a glorious Church! What is the mark of the glorious church, how do we know who is going to be there? They do) not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish. (They come to perfection that is why we are going on to perfection. I've had people say, "You sound like you are just too much I have to come to perfection?" That is right you do that is the word of God, that is what God will bring forth. People that say that are people that do not want to deal with themselves. They do not want to believe that they are responsible to come to the place of perfection. Everybody is to become the perfection to be a part of the glorious church)

No spot, no wrinkle, holy, and without blemish that is where we are headed, that is where you are headed, and that is where we are going to be, and that is it so get committed that you are going to hear, and do the word across the board, and you are going to get to the place where you are strong and mighty, and you are walking in authority, and you are going to be steadfast in your soul, he who endures is steadfast "Hoop-om-on-ay" to the end, you have to be steadfast it does not matter what happens, and you are going to see things that are going to be astounding. You cannot be moved remember the holy tabernacle is God in us, the completed work the river of living water is going to be coming out of us, god is in the midst of her song 46 that we talked about "She shall not be moved" you are not going to be moved by anything. Why? Because all that is going to be in you is the word. Remember who was the ones that came to the perfected glorious state? All they had was the word in them, that is what was in them, just the tablets of

stone the word, and that is all that is to be in you, that means God has done the total work. And when the word is in you that is the way you will respond, that is the way you will think, that is the way you will speak, that is the way you will deal with everything, and you put this flesh down, and you are walking in line with the word, that is it. That is why we emphasize the word, and obeying the commandments, because we cannot have any lawlessness or unrighteousness whatsoever, or judgment will come. Remember the judgment is going to come it does not matter whether you are born again or not anybody that has sin in the camp or walk in unrighteousness or judgment they are going to get hit for sure. So we are going onto perfection, we are going to be holy without blemish, we are going to see this tremendous work, and you cannot do anything yourself. It is God who does the work, you do have a part to play allowing him do it, hair and do the word, and walk in it, and obey everything he says, and then he will accomplish his great work. Praise God for the great work he has done and what he is going to continue to do, and He will complete the work. Remember he began a good work, and he will complete it to the day of Christ if we will just walk in his ways, and let him have his way in our life.
