<p>Style and ethos 1 points</p>	<p>-written with an intelligent, interested audience in mind, with collegial tone and clear writing -conveys that a credible, reliable author stands behind this essay (this is affected by typos, spelling, punctuation and grammar</p>		<p>Either overly casual or overly academic/formal ...overblown and wordy. Distracting typos or errors</p>
