## 2. Chinami Aomori ♦ - Played by:

Chinami is an 'otaku'. She'd label herself as a weeb, but she's already Japanese. Is it possible to be *too* obsessed with your own culture? She owns countless plushies of all of her favourite anime characters, dozens of posters of smiling magical girls and grinning Shonen Jump stars and hundreds of anime figurines. To add to her collection, she also has multiple replicas of objects used in animes, such as magical girl wands and Naruto headbands. The icing atop the teetering cake is where she gets her money from. After all, an anime empire doesn't come cheap. Chinami's job is at an *anime-themed maid cafe*, acting like a tsundere to appeal to the other weeps who visit the restaurant. Her personality is rather unremarkable; an easily-excitable, gullible, naive girl with an obsessive personality and way too many hyperfixations to count. She is loyal, however, and finds that making friends is easy for her. The only problem she ever encounters with other people is that they just don't *understand* her and her anime. She stays up late every night watching anime and reading manga, so she frequently falls asleep during class. She wants to be a manga artist when she grows up.



Voice Type: High-pitched. She sounds like she's very excited to be speaking at most times and barely has enough breath to voice all of her thoughts.

Lines: (Audibly grinning)"Hey! It's amazing to meet you! My name is Aomori and I'm the second member of Fallen Ai! Do you wanna see my Miku Figures?"

(Frantic) "Mooooom, you don't understand! I have to wait outside Anime'R'Us at 3 am because if I don't, the limited edition Goku figurines will be sold out! And then I will *literally die.*"

(Pleased) "My precious Goku, in my hands at last."

"I *know* I'm forgetting something...milk, water, bread....oh! Sugar, honey, ice, tea! I forgot the rice flour!"

(Slightly irritated, through gritted teeth)"Those people at school don't understand me. Nobody does!... Nobody except you, Miku-Chan. At least I'll always have you."

(Talking to her Goku figurine)"Why does nobody get me? (Imitates Goku)You're just too cool Aomori-Chan! (Back to normal self)You're absolutely right, my precious."

3. Aneko Chisaka ♡ - Played by:

Aneko's name literally means 'older sister', which is kind of funny when you realise she has ten younger siblings. Each one thinks her name is incredibly hilarious. Just because she has plenty of 妹 and 弟 at home, doesn't mean that her older sister instincts go away when she leaves the house. She very much acts as the mom of the group- she has ever since she was little, which was always rather cute. Imagine a little girl bossing all of her friends around and threatening to tell their mothers if they misbehaved. This didn't really win her many friends though, no matter how adorable it was. She is strict, stern and doesn't trust easily, although she will try and be nice to everyone, justifying her kindness with the claim that if she were in their position, she'd want a friend. She's very much against drinking and drugs, often being labelled as a bit of a stick in the mud. She's rarely invited to parties because of this.



Voice type: Stern, low and powerful. Her voice is one that commands attention and respect.

Lines: (Smile in her voice)"Good morning, my name is Chisaka, the third member of Fallen Ai, second member of Neon Skies. It's so nice to meet you and I hope we'll be good friends!"

(Stern)"Let him go this instant. Don't let me catch you here again."

(Heartbroken)"I thought you were being nice to me because you cared..."

"This room is a mess! Come on, everyone get a dust rag- we're cleaning up before lunch."

" Hey...it's okay. You'll be fine, I promise."

"I swear to the gods, you touch her again and I'll snap your spine."

#### 4. Moon-Yeon Ko ₩ - Played By:

Originally from South Korea, Moon moved to Japan when she was 14. She has a bit of a harsh personality, being rather cold and callous to most people, as she's a bit of a misanthrope. She can't stand most human beings, due to the fact that she finds them incredibly annoying. She has a bit of a problem with alcohol and cigarettes, but is trying to get better for Aneko's sake, because they're childhood friends and Aneko is worried about her. She's rude, calculating and analytical. She enjoys mathematics and science. Moon's favourite colours are neons. She joins the group reluctantly, mostly to just find out about her past life, which she didn't even initially believe in until indubitable evidence was thrown in her face. She's quite grumpy most of the time, coming off as rather standoffish and brusque. She has an older brother that used to be rather rude to her in the past.



Voice Type: Even, stoic and serious. Her voice is rather low and smooth.

Lines: “Not that it’s any of your business, but I’m Ko Moon-Yeon. Now, try not to get in my way.”

(Even, stoic)”If you would kindly fuck off and leave me to my business, I would be most grateful.”

(Stern and angry)”Fuck off! You don’t know anything about me!”

(Slight smile in her voice)”I guess you’re not *all* bad.”

(Calculating)”The plan is this: if she meets us up at 4, we have just about 10 minutes to look through her bag. If we find it, good. If we don’t, we’re screwed.”

“Good god, do any of you *ever* shut up?”

#### 5. Momo Aishi ♡ - Played by:

Momo, on the outside, is a rather sweet and polite girl. She aims to please- always showing off her gentle smiles and kind laughs. Momo tries to portray herself as a perfect angel, always being oh so sweet and nice to everyone. However, underneath all of that excessive sugar is a sour, cruel personality. She’s manipulative and angry, losing her temper even on a good day. Don’t get on her bad side, or she *will* end you. To her close accomplices, she’s perfectly decent and kind, but not to strangers and enemies. Her favourite colour is pink, she loves shoujo anime and mochi. Her parents have always been rather distant, which is probably why she never believes it if someone tells her they want to be her friend. She’s oftentimes rather sad, too. A strange melancholy vibe surrounds her.



Voice Type: Momo’s voice is sweet, high and sugary. She sounds like your typical anime girl, with a slighter lower voice and tone.

Lines: (Smiling)”Hiya! My name is Aishi! I’m so happy to meet you. I’m sure we’ll be the *best* of friends.”

(Beaming)”Is that what you said? (Smile abruptly vanishes, she turns serious and grave) I sure hope that’s not what you said. I think I’d have to make you regret it if you did.”

(Angry) "What?! What?!?! What do you *mean*, she's gone? Where the fuck did she go!?"

(Pretending to be sweet) "Why don't I help you, sensei?"

(Voice empty) "What did you say?"

"Try not to cross me next time. Okay?"

#### 6. Lihua Sun ☾ - Played by:

She struggles with making friends because of that initial distrust that she can never quite get over.



Voice Type: Lihua's voice is soft, gentle and timid. She's rather shy, unless someone just so happens to stumble across her hyperfixations in a conversation, when her true passion is unleashed.
