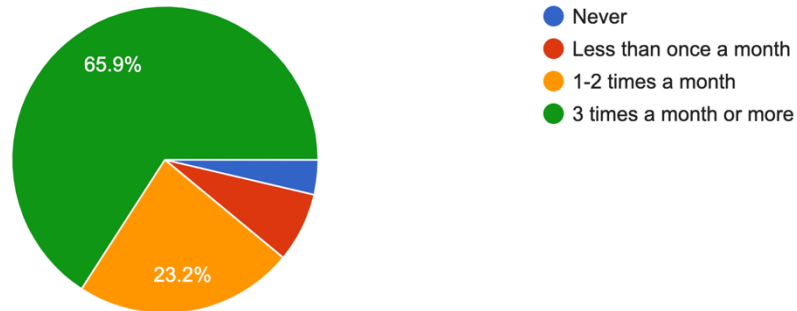


All Souls Worship Survey – Summary Findings

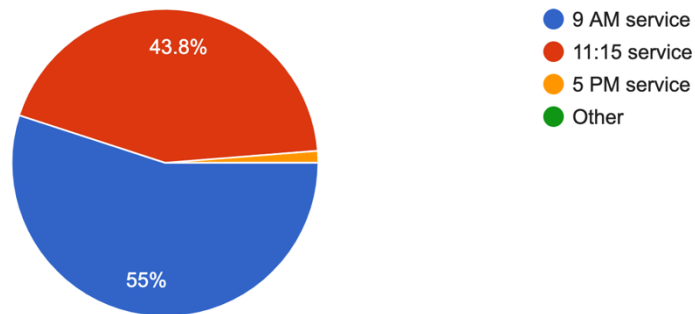
How frequently do you attend any of the 3 Sunday Services (9AM, 11:15AM, and 5PM) ?

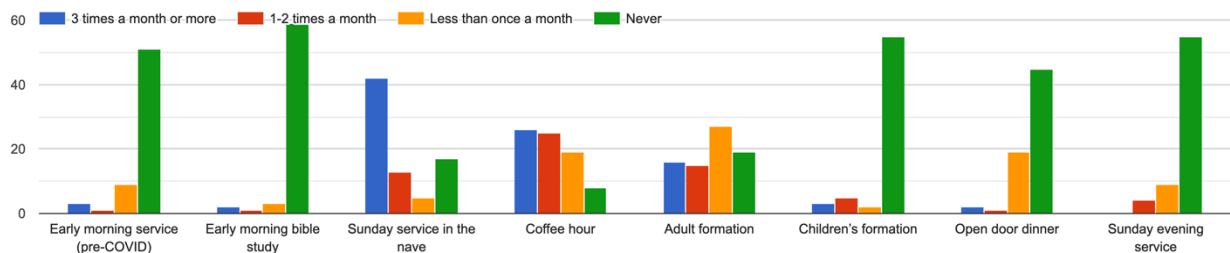


Which Sunday service do you attend most frequently?

How frequently do you participate in the following Sunday activities?

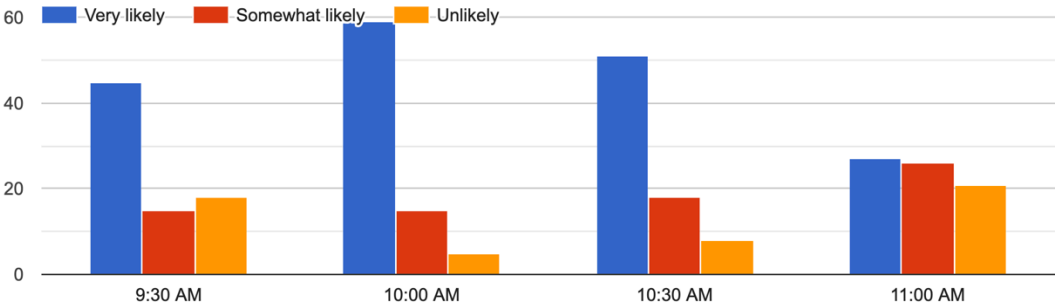


If there were a single Sunday service, would you prefer that it be:

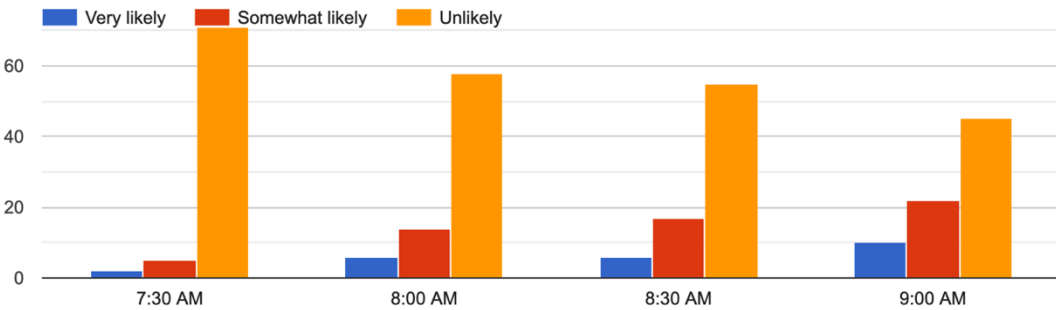

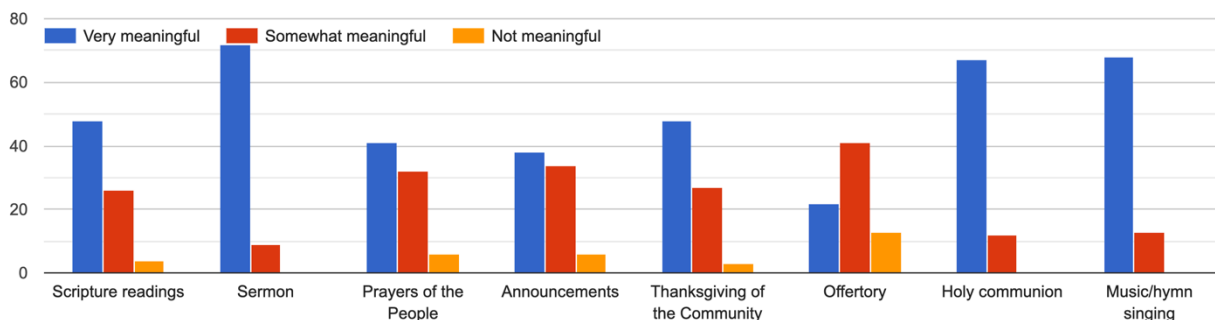
How likely would you be to attend a single Sunday service in the main worship space if it started at:



All Souls is considering adding back a short, contemplative early morning service (normally without music) in the chapel. How likely are you to attend a chapel service if it starts at:

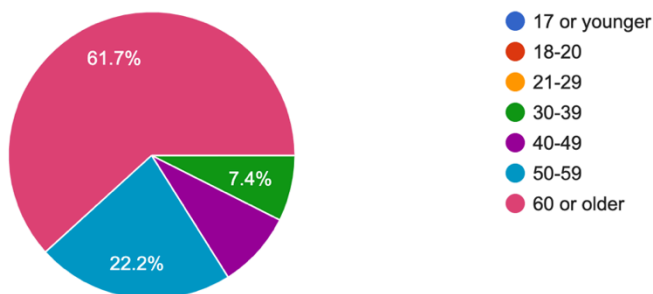


What parts of the Sunday service are most meaningful to you?

Responses from those with children:

12 responses from people with children under 18.

10/12 go to the 9:00 service.

10/12 said they wanted a shorter service (similar to the 9 AM).

A 10:00 start time seems to work for this group.

Most do not participate in formation or do it rarely.

6 said they would attend formation during service, 1 said after, the remainder did not respond.

A slightly larger share of this group said they did not find scripture readings meaningful.

Received about 40 open-ended comments. Summary of those related to Sunday schedule:

1. Prefer one service
 - a. So we have more people together *****
 - b. So we can do more with limited resources
2. Would like a shorter service/concern about length of service *****

- a. Reduce the prayers of the people** or Thanksgivings (can get tedious)
- 3. Related to formation:
 - a. Would like to be able to attend both the early service and adult formation.
 - b. Would like childcare during adult formation so parents can attend
 - c. Put formation before service so there's enough time for coffee hour after
 - d. Would like service and adult formation to be available early/mid morning**
 - e. Prefer children's formation during adult formation (rather than during service) so teachers don't have to miss service
 - f. Don't want to have to choose between Formation and RBTL
- 4. Keep the Sunday night service **
- 5. Keep lots of music *** esp Angel Band**
- 6. Don't eliminate any element of the 11:15 service** except maybe the Thanksgivings
- 7. Concerned about crowding/mandatory livestreaming
- 8. Ensure changes continue to welcome children
- 9. Consider that construction due to Living Waters may impact our schedules in the future
- 10. Not attending because of COVID, still not comfortable indoors**

Comment themes – not related to schedule:

- 11. Would like healing space in the side chapel instead of the back
- 12. We need temporary name tags
- 13. Location of coffee hour isn't ideal – better in parish hall?
- 14. Would like a monitor so people could watch the service in the parish hall if needed
- 15. Like the two options for taking the wine
- 16. Love Dent
- 17. Love meditative silences
- 18. Do not like kids sitting up front, would like diverse readers and inclusive language, we need a more consistent strategy for welcoming visitors
- 19. Want better formation for teens esp about the Episcopal church
- 20. It has been difficult for me to connect with people at ASP – people are stand-offish

Areas for discussion:

- Decision to go to one service in nave
- Timing/duration of main service
- Decision on contemplative service - do we need it? Format/music?
- When to start each element
- Scheduling of formation before or after & relationship to coffee hour
- Potential conflict with O.D.D.
