 □ Compass or GPS: Know how to use it. □ Map: Of the camping area. □ Multi-Tool: With a knife and other handy tools. □ Headlamp/Flashlight: With extra batteries.

 □ Camera: For capturing memories. □ Notebook and Pencil: For jotting down observations or memories. □ Sunglasses: UV-protection rated. □ Entertainment: Such as a deck of cards or a book. □ Wildlife Guidebooks: For nature observation. □ Portable Charger: For electronic devices. □ Cooling Towel: For relief from heat. 	
Group Gear (Divide Among Troop)	
 □ Tents: With rainfly and groundsheet. □ Water Filtration System: For clean drinking water. □ First Aid Kit: Comprehensive for the group. □ Tarp: For additional shelter or ground cover. □ Ropes: For various uses around camp.
