- Theme & Aesthetic: We are especially interested in works featuring Valentine's Day colors, neutrals, and pastel tones. (see example)



- Sales: Artists will retain 70% of sales, with the remaining 30% taken as commission
- **Installation:** Work must be available for installation during the two weeks leading up to the show. Artists are responsible for ensuring that their artwork is properly prepared for installation (e.g., with appropriate hanging hardware, such as wire on the back).

- **Submission form**: Please include a completed submission form (attached below), which must be affixed to the back of your artwork for identification and contact purposes.

## **Exhibition & Submission Requirements:**

- All submissions must be ready to hang, with proper hanging devices (e.g., wire on the back of paintings or prints).
- Artwork must not exceed 36"x36" in size.
- Artwork should not exceed 40 lbs in weight.
- Artwork drop-off: Artwork must be dropped off in person at Commune Norfolk during the installation period, between Feb 10th-12th between 10AM - 3PM (see commune hours) Specific drop-off times will be communicated upon submission.
- **Artwork return:** Artwork can be collected from 10:00 AM–4:00 PM between March 10 and March 14, 2025.

While we will take all necessary precautions, artists are encouraged to insure their work if desired. All artwork will be accepted for display only and will not be for sale unless explicitly stated by the artist.
