### Medication-Based Treatment

#### Treatment Provider List

During your visit to MedStar Franklin Square Hospital, you may have received medication to treat Opioid Use Disorder. Using medication as part of your recovery process can be helpful and many local treatment programs also offer medication as part of their services.

In the next day, a **Peer Recovery Coach** from the hospital will call you to discuss a plan for the next steps regarding your recovery. You can also reach them at **443.777.2587** or **443.777.2586**. If you're interested in treatment, they can help get you an appointment and address any concerns you have.

Regardless of your plan or willingness to work with a Peer Recovery Coach, you can walk into any of the below treatment programs and be evaluated for admission into their program. They may recommend you begin medication for Opioid Use Disorder. These programs are eager to help you and can also answer questions and concerns you may have related to the next steps in your recovery journey.
