

XIV Jon. I: Decree on the Spheres of Influence of Lichtenstein (17 April 2014)

The Grade One Sphere of Influence of the Town of Lichtenstein shall be the land enclosed within the following boundary: National Cycle Network route 51, from its junction with Station Road to the boundary between the second and third fields on the northern side of said cycle route counting down from its junction with Gravel Bridge Road; north-north-east up said boundary and continuing along the boundaries of the adjacent fields in a near-straight line (thereby running along the western boundary of the field directly to the east of the path leading south from Willingham Road to Coldharbour Farm) until it reaches Willingham Road; east along Willingham Road until where the road meets with the eastern boundary of the field adjoining Willingham Barns, continuing north-north-east up said boundary to the road known as Furtherford, and continuing west along Furtherford until Long Lane; north up Long Lane to the place at which Long Lane meets with Ouse Fen Road or Bank and two smaller paths; south-west along the footpath which connects said place with Chain/Overcote Road; then continuing down Overcote Road and Church End (connected by a small part of Over High Street) to Station Road, and continuing down Station Road to its junction with National Cycle Network route 51.

The Grade Two Sphere of Influence of the Town of Lichtenstein shall be the land enclosed within the same boundary as delineated by Paragraph 3 of the Emperorsland Act 2013.

The Grade Three Sphere of Influence of the Town of Lichtenstein shall be the British parliamentary constituencies of Cambridge, South Cambridgeshire (not including that part of it to the south-east of the A10 road), South East Cambridgeshire (not including that part of it to the south of the A1307 road), North East Cambridgeshire (not including that part of it to the north of the A47 road), North West Cambridgeshire (not including that part of it to the west of the A1 road), and Huntingdon.

Decreed at Wrythe this seventeenth day of April during the second year of our reign, on Maundy (Great and Holy) Thursday, in the year of the consulship of Eritoshi Augusta and Imperator Caesar Jonathan Augustus.
