CONCENTRATING ON DOUBLES

Strategy: doubles

Materials · <u>Concentrating on Doubles cards</u>, 1 or 2 sets for each pair

Have students play individually or in pairs.

Students place all cards face down and spread out on a desk or on the floor.

The players turn up two cards at a time.

The object is to match the doubles number expression with the correct sum card. If a player finds a match, he or she keeps the cards. If the cards do not match, they are turned back over in the same place. Students working independently may want to use an egg timer to see how many matches they can find before the timer runs out. If playing in pairs, the player with the most matches wins
