  - New Standards (Programs of Study) Implementation Timeline/Support
    - To be implemented in 2023-2024
    - NCE sessions will feature this as well as Fall Workshops
  - LB 520 Amendment to Computer Science & Technology Act
    - Introduced by Senator Walz January 17, 2023
    - Committee Hearing February 7, 2023

- Change provisions relating to high school graduation requirements and academic content standards and the Computer Science and Technology Education Act
- "The five high school credit hour requirement may be met by a single course or combination of high school courses that cover the computer science and technology academic content standards" in addition to moving back the implementation by one year.
- LB 610 CTE State Funding (16:56 on Recording)
  - Introduced by Senator Lippincot on January 17, 2023
  - Committe hearing March 15, 2023
  - Approximately \$8,000,000 will be distributed to secondary and post secondary schools following the federal Perkins formula, while an additional \$2,232,000 will ensure that each school district in the state receives a minimum of \$15,000 for career and technical education. LB610 also appropriates \$400,000 to the Department of Education to be evenly distributed between the career education student organizations."
