#### **INTERVIEW TRANSCRIPT:**

RESEARCHER: So, how ya doing today?

SCP-527: I'm doing pretty good, how about yourself?

**RESEARCHER:** I'm doing fine, thanks for asking.

SCP-527: No problem.

RESEARCHER: Alright. So, this interview will mainly be about your water gun, if

you don't mind.

SCP-527: Sounds good.

RESEARCHER: Great. Let's get into it. When exactly did you obtain your water

qun? Did someone give it to you, or did you just find it?

**SCP-527:** Oh, I got it off Craigslist.

**RESEARCHER**: Really?

**SCP-527:** Yeah, it was a pretty good buy if you ask me.

RESEARCHER: Huh. Neat. Anyway, does your water gun ever run out of water? If

so, how do you refill it?

**SCP-527:** Nope, it just kinda lasts forever. No maintenance needed.



**RESEARCHER:** I see. The bubbles they produce, do you have any control over the size or shape of them?

**SCP-527:** Nah. There's only a few options I can choose from, they're all about the same size.

**RESEARCHER:** Uh huh. Jumping back to that earlier question, do you remember who you bought it from?

SCP-527: No idea, sorry. Goldfish memory.

**RESEARCHER:** Just to be sure, does "Dr. Wondertainment" ring any bells from the person, place, or thing you bought the qun from?

**SCP-527:** I am not too sure. It kinda just showed up on my shoes. No matter what pair I put on. Pretty weird.

(SCP-999 COMES IN AND SAYS HI TO SCP-527)

SCP-527: Oh, hey! What's up blob?

[O34 COMES IN AND KILLS THE ENTIRE CAFETERIA, INCLUDING ME]

SCP-527: What the- Hey! What's your problem!

(527 BEGINS CHASING THE 034, ATTEMPTING TO HIT IT WITH HIS CANE)

(I ARRIVE BACK TO THE PHI CAFETERIA AFTER THE 034 DIES)

**SCP-527:** What was his problem?

**RESEARCHER:** I believe he was an 034.

**SCP-527:** Freak. Don't help him, blob. Alright, I gotta finish up the interview.

**SCP-527:** I just flip a switch on the gun and that's what shoots out of it. Pretty simple!

**RESEARCHER:** I see. Is there any limit to the amount of bubbles you can generate at once?

**SCP-527:** Yeah.

**RESEARCHER:** What would that limit be?

SCP-527: It'll only shoot three normal bubbles, and one of the special ones.

**RESEARCHER:** I see. How interesting.

**RESEARCHER**: Are you capable of altering the bubbles beyond that of what the gun does by itself?

**SCP-527:** Uhh, I can hit it with my cane to change the direction. Otherwise, that's it. I can demonstrate if you want.

**RESEARCHER:** No. Thanks, though.

SCP-527: Oh yeah, I can also speed it up.

RESEARCHER: Uh huh.

**SCP-527:** Yep.

**RESEARCHER:** How durable are your bubbles? Do you know if there's anything that can destroy them?



**SCP-527:** I'd say they are pretty durable. Over time they pop on their own, otherwise there's nothing else that can really pop it.

RESEARCHER: Cool, good to know.

**RESEARCHER**: Do you know the maximum distance a bubble can travel before it pops? As you said, it pops over time. Do you know exactly how much time?

**SCP-527:** I don't know the exact time, but I know it lasts for quite a while.

**RESEARCHER:** I see. Well, I believe that's all I had for you. Thank you for your participation.

**SCP-527:** Cool, no worries. Let me know if you got any more questions.

RESEARCHER: Will do.

# ——INTERVIEW CONCLUSION—

**CONCLUSION:** Overall, I would say this interview had plenty of discoveries to it. I found most of SCP-527's answers were generally interesting and somewhat enlightening. SCP-527 has shown extensive knowledge of his bubble gun, despite him not even being the original owner. The interview has shown most of the functions and origins of SCP-527's bubble gun that, as far as I know, was previously unknown.

First off, he did not randomly find or obtain his bubble gun from an individual he knows. He says he bought the gun off of Craigslist, which is quite strange in my opinion. Alongside this, the bubble gun doesn't appear to require any maintenance. The bubble gun automatically refills itself and never runs out of water to use. He doesn't have any control over the bubbles other than what the bubble gun already does by itself, either. SCP-527 also has a limit on how many bubbles he can produce at once, with the limit being 3 normal bubbles and 1 special bubble. The bubbles are extraordinarily durable, and cannot be popped by



conventional methods. They can only be popped through time. When questioned about this, SCP-527 says he doesn't know how much time it takes exactly.

Based on the information I've gathered today, I can come to the reasonable conclusion that the bubble gun is probably the most anomalous and dangerous part of SCP-527, and isn't even that dangerous on top of that. While the bubble gun can cause harm, it has limits that prevent it from causing too much damage, such as the limit of bubbles it can fire at once. SCP-527 himself is just a fish man that can jump slightly higher, however, the bubble gun has most of the strange properties.
