BLM manages more than 22 million acres of surface estate plus the subsurface mineral rights to an additional ~650,000 acres in the ~23 million-acre NPR-A.

The BLM generally conducts annual oil and gas lease sales in the NPR-A. In May 1999, the BLM held its first NPR-A lease sale since 1984, offering nearly 3.9 million acres within the Northeast Planning Area. Since 1999, the BLM has held lease sales in both the Northwest (NW) and Northeast (NE) Planning Areas. A February 2013 [Record of Decision](#) opened tracts for leasing in the southern NPR-A, and tracts in the far west were created after a 2014 deferral expired.

The [NPR-A Integrated Activity Plan](#) will better balance protection of the environment, wildlife, subsistence uses, local concerns, and oil and gas opportunities offered in future lease sales. The [Record of Decision](#) for the new IAP, signed by the Secretary Dec. 31, 2020 includes important safeguards for wildlife and sensitive resources, while allowing for responsible oil and gas leasing across 18.6 million acres of the NPR-A. These safeguards include no surface occupancy, controlled surface use, timing limitations and provide for new and emerging technologies to access subsurface resources while maintaining important surface values. The new IAP closes more than 4 million acres to leasing.

[Coastal Plain of the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge](#)

The 1,563,500-acre Coastal Plain is highly prospective for oil and gas resources, estimated to contain between 4.25 and 11.8 billion barrels of technically recoverable oil. The entire oil program area will be made available to oil and gas leasing subject to applicable lease stipulations and required operating procedures.

The BLM conducted its first lease sale in the Coastal Plain of ANWR Jan. 6, 2021, pursuant to the Coastal Plain Oil and Gas Leasing Program [August 2020 Record of Decision](#) (ROD) with any future oil and gas development actions requiring a separate detailed environmental analysis.

[Secretary of the Interior Order 3401](#): In June 2021 [suspended all activities](#) related to implementing the Coastal Plain Oil and Gas Leasing Program pending completion of a comprehensive analysis under the National Environmental Policy Act.

An Aug. 4, 2021, [Federal Register](#) notice of intent to prepare a supplemental environmental impact statement initiated the [scoping process](#) to begin the comprehensive analysis of potential environmental impacts, including addressing deficiencies identified in the Secretary's order.

BLM, No. 1:18-cv- 00187-REB, this sale does not include 20 parcels that intersect with Greater Sage Grouse Priority and General Habitat Management Areas.

Responsible energy development includes thoughtful consideration of parcels nominated for leasing as well as potential resource impacts of decisions to lease. BLM Wyoming extends comment period for nominated parcels in sage-grouse habitat: BLM Wyoming is seeking further input on the environmental analysis for parcels in sage-grouse habitat in our proposed fourth quarter lease sale in order to comply with a recent District of

Idaho Court Order [*W. Watersheds Project v. BLM*, No. 1:18-cv-00187-REB, 2018 U.S. Dist. (D. Idaho Sept. 21, 2018)].

To comply with a Preliminary Injunction entered on Sept. 21, 2018, by the District Court, the BLM is extending the comment period through through Nov. 9, 2018, for 578 parcels in Greater Sage-grouse habitat. These parcels will now be analyzed as part of a supplemental sale expected to occur in February 2019. After accepting and analyzing comments, we will post a sale notice announcing the supplemental sale and initiate a 30-day protest period. The BLM initially released the analysis for a 14-day comment period on Aug. 29, 2018. You can find the environmental documents for the sale at <https://go.usa.gov/xUAjm>. Submit your comments, including name and mailing address, at this site by 4 p.m. on Nov. 9.

BLM to offer three parcels in December lease sale: The BLM plans to offer three parcels totaling about 720 acres at its December quarterly oil and gas lease sale. We will publish the sale notice for this sale on Friday, Oct. 26, initiating a 10-day public protest period that ends on Monday, Nov. 5, 2018. To comply with a Preliminary Injunction entered Sept. 21, 2018, by the U.S. District Court, District of Idaho [*W. Watersheds Project v. BLM*, No. 1:18-cv-00187-REB, 2018 U.S. Dist. (D. Idaho Sept. 21, 2018)], this sale does not include 578 parcels that intersect with Greater Sage-grouse priority and general habitat management areas.

Responsible energy development includes thoughtful consideration of parcels nominated for leasing as well as potential resource impacts of decisions to lease. An additional environmental review will take place at the application for permit to drill stage, where site-specific conditions of approval are placed on permits in addition to lease stipulations.
