 - b. Write a reflection of 250 words for each one of the editorial. In this reflection
 - i. Discuss the language choices of the author (diction and rhetorical devices)
 - ii. Discuss the ways this author either builds credibility or creates incredulity on the part of the reader.
 - iii. Discuss the targeted audience for the article.
