# Grant Guidelines

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Carrboro High School's Athletic Booster Club (ABC) is pleased to offer the opportunity to sanctioned teams to request funding through the ABC Grant Program. The purpose of the grants is to provide teams with funds to cover the cost of items typically not covered by the CHS Athletic Department. The focus of the grants is on skill development for players, teams and coaches. A priority is placed on funding grants impacting high numbers of student athletes.

## **Grant Requests**

Team coaches and/or parent representatives are encouraged to complete the grant form to request funds. Grants will be reviewed three times each year:

- August,
- November, and
- March

## **Eligible Teams**

Any team sanctioned by the school and district may apply for a grant. Sanctioned teams are teams that receive funding from the school, district and/or conference and play in the NCHSAA. Clubs or club teams are not eligible for grants.

## **Funding**

Each grant will be considered and funded at the highest level possible. Typical items covered by the ABC Grant Program include, but are not limited to, equipment, team camps/clinics, and uniforms. Up to 50% of major equipment requests will be granted, if money is available.

Club funds will be used to purchase items that will benefit the CHS Athletic program for at least two years or encourage student participation in athletic programs.

Uniform requests will be funded based on the CHS Athletic Department's planned four-year rotation, at which time the team, CHS Boosters and CHS Athletic department will share the costs equally.

Grant requests to cover the cost of food/beverages and senior recognition events will not be funded as these should be funded from the team account.

## **Clinics, Camps & Training**

Clinics, Camps, & Training sessions strengthen and improve our teams, coaches and athletes by seeking knowledge from sources outside our school.

Sanctioned Carrboro High School athletic teams can apply for Carrboro High School Athletic Boosters' Grants for Clinics, Camps and/or Training in amounts up to \$1,000 per school year per team. Actual amount given to teams by Boosters could vary depending upon Boosters funds.

- Clinics can be for coaches or the team. Clinics for individual athletes, unless for specialized training (e.g. pitching, goalkeeping, etc.), will not be approved.
- Grant money can be used for the following:
  - Tuition
  - Fees
  - Registration
  - Training materials
  - Lodging
  - Meals
  - Transportation
- Money approved, but not used, does not rollover for use in later years or grant periods.
- Outside sources can include programs at schools, universities and colleges (both in state and out of state), recognized, leading coaches in their sport, or other sources as reviewed and approved by Boosters and the school's Athletic Director.

## **AD Consultation**

Before the final award is granted to the team, the CHS Athletic Director will be consulted to confirm the request is in line with the overall plan for the CHS Athletic Department. Given the CHS Booster Club's limited budget, costs may be shared with the CHS Athletic Department and the team.
