General Guidelines for Entries:

- 1. The Fair is open to all Milam County residents or Youth attending school in Milam County.
- 2. Age Categories (as of entry date of show):

Beginners K-2nd Grades

Junior 3-5 Grades

Intermediates 6-8 Grades

Seniors 9-12 Grades

Adults Ages 19 and above (Those not attending 12th grade anymore)

AGE EXCEPTION Quilts Categories (Quilts I, II, and III) will be divided into Youth and Adult AGE DIVISIONS:

Youth: K-12th grade

Adult: Ages 19 and above (Those not attending 12th grade anymore)

- ***Groups/Teams are also welcome to enter together for the Quilt Categories.
- 3. All exhibits must have been completed since the last Rockdale Fair-October 2024.
- **4.** All exhibits must be NEW and not a variation or duplication from past year's entries.
- **5.** All exhibits must be made by the exhibitors themselves.
- **6.** All exhibits will be judged, and ribbons awarded as follows for each category:
 - Each division MUST have one grand champion, and one reserve champion selected from 1st place winners in the division. (All divisions MUST be awarded a Grand and Reserve Champion)
 - The divisions will be divided into classes depending on the number of entries.
 - · Classes in each division will receive ribbons for 1st through 5th places.
 - · A Best of Show Winner will be selected from the Grand Champions in each age category.
- **7.** Entry forms will be available at the time of registration or prior to the show from:

8. Maximum Entries per Division:

One entry per participant for the following divisions:

- · Decorated Cakes and Cupcakes
- · Collections

Six entries per participant for the divisions on the division page (excluding baked goods) Example:

- · One bread, one cake, one cookie, one candy, one pie for a total of **five** entries in the Baked Goods Division.- **No misc category.**
- · Three cakes and three pies for a total of six entries in the Baked Goods Division
 - · One wreath, five tree decorations for a total of six entries in the Christmas Craft Division
- · One collection is the maximum entry for the collection Division
- 9. All entries must be checked in and checked out at the assigned times.
- **10.** Every precaution will be taken to protect articles entered, but in no case will the Rockdale Fair Association or the FCH Committee be responsible for loss, damage, theft or breakage or other forms of loss.
- **11.** Pictures: Pictures will take place at **5:00pm** on Wednesday, October 15, 2025. We will take pictures of Best of Show winners, Grands and Reserve Champion (they will receive their rewards).
- 12. Home Economics Division participants are <u>NOT</u> required to attend the REQUIRED set-up days given by the Rockdale Fair Association.

CLOTHING:

Afghans

- Maximum Entries: Six entries per participant
- · Possible Classes may be: Crochet; Knit, Weaving

Clothing Art and Handwork Accessories

- · Maximum Entries: Six entries per participant
- · Handwork Accessories: Knitted Items, Sewn Clothing
- · Clothing Art: Clothing must be on hangers for display
- · Possible Classes may be: Embellished Clothing; Designed T-shirt Art, Recycled/Repurposed clothing, etc.

Hand Stitchery/Needlework

- · Maximum Entries: Six entries per participant
- · Possible Classes may be: Needlepoint; Embroidery; Cross-Stitched; Candlewicking, Smocking, Crewel, Counted Cross-Stitch etc.

QUILTS:

Quilts I – Hand and Machine Quilted (any size EXCEPT BED SIZED QUILTS)

- · Maximum Entries: Six entries per participant
- · NO BED SIZED QUILTS
- · Any quilted piece- hand and/or machine quilted (such as: table runner; wall hangers; lap quilt; etc) ·

Possible Classes may be: table runner; wall hangers; lap quilt; etc

· Age Divisions: Youth and Adult Divisions and Groups/Teams can enter a quilt together

Quilts II - Hand Quilted Bed Sized Quilts (any BED sized)

- · Maximum Entries: Six entries per participant
- · Any hand quilted BED SIZED piece
- · Classes will be: Twin, Double, Queen, King
- · Age Divisions: Youth and Adult Divisions and Groups/Teams can enter a quilt together

Quilts III – Machine Quilted Bed Sized Quilts (any BED sized)

- · Maximum Entries: Six entries per participant
- · Any machine guilted BED SIZED piece
- · Classes will be: Twin, Double, Queen, King
- · Age Divisions: Youth and Adult Divisions and Groups/Teams can enter a quilt together

FOOD:

Baked Goods

- · Maximum Entries: Six entries per participant
- · Recipes Must Be Attached to the Entries
- · No professional bakers are allowed to enter
- · Classes include: Bread (1 loaf or 3 rolls); Cookies (6 of a kind); Pies; Cakes; Candy (6 of a kind); Cupcakes (6 of a kind), Cake Balls (6 of a kind), etc.
- · Disposal containers are recommended for food entries
- · Please provide a cut piece of your baked good and put it in an airtight container for the judge to sample.

Decorated Cake and Cupcakes

- · Maximum Entries: One entry per participant
- · Recipes Must Be Attached to the Entries
- · No professional bakers are allowed to enter
- · Decorated cakes must be completely edible including the decorations and garnishes.
- · Classes include: Cakes, Cupcakes (6 of a kind)
- · Disposal containers can be used for food entries.
- · Please provide a cut piece of your baked good and put it in an airtight container for the judge to sample.

Canned Foods

- · Maximum Entries: Six entries per participant
- · All canned products must be exhibited in standard canning jars and sealed with new lids
- · Possible Classes may be: Vegetables; Pickles; Relishes; Fruit; Juices; Salsa; Jams; Jellies

Produce

- · Maximum Entries: Six entries per participant
- · Produce must be grown by the exhibitor
- · Entry consists of 4-6 small items (such as peppers, tomatoes, etc.) or 1 large item (such as a pumpkin) ·

Possible Classes may be: Fruits, Vegetables, Eggs, etc.

Horticulture

- · Maximum Entries: Six entries per participant
- · All plants entered need to have been cared for by the exhibitor for at least 6 months
- · All single specimens must be displayed in a bottle
- · All single specimens must be cut from plants cared for by the exhibitor for at least 6 months
- · Possible Classes may be: Single Specimen; Ferns; Blooming Plants-Potted; Hanging Baskets; Cacti and Succulents; Potted Foliage Plants; etc.

CREATIVE ARTS:

Collections

- · Maximum Entries: One entry per participant
- · Collection is a group of five or more items
- · Collections are limited to 36 inch table space
- · Collections cannot be an addition or duplication of an entry from past years.
- · Collection ideas Dolls; Insects; Buttons; Flowers; Shells; Sport Cards; Stamps: Rocks; etc.

Creative Arts and Crafts

- Maximum Entries: Six entries per participant
- · Possible Classes may be: Ceramics; Porcelain; Jewelry; Models; Leatherwork; Scrapbooks, Artistic Arrangements, etc.

Floral Arrangements

- · Maximum Entries: Six entries per participant
- · All flower arrangements entered need to be fresh cut flowers and arranged in a jar, vase, or other artistic method · All potted plants will continue to be judged in horticulture.
- · Possible Classes may be: funeral sprays, table top/centerpiece arrangements, wreaths, bouquets, misc

Holiday Crafts

- · Maximum Entries: Six entries per participant
- · Possible Classes may be: ANY HOLIDAY- Tree Decorations; Wreaths, Centerpieces; etc.

Recycled Arts and Crafts

· Maximum Entries: Six entries per participant

· Possible Classes may be: Folk art, Jewelry, Arts and Crafts general, etc

Woodworking Division

- · Maximum Entries: Six entries per participant
- Possible Classes may be: Furniture; Accessories; Toys; Houses; etc.

ART:

Drawings Division

- · Maximum Entries: Six entries per participant
- · Entries must be mounted, matted or framed
- · Entries can be pen, ink, charcoal, chalk, crayon or other media that includes drawing only
- · Possible Classes may be: Animals, People, Landscape, Still Life, Flora/Plant, etc.

Paintings Division

- · Maximum Entries: Six entries per participant
- · Entries must be mounted, matted or framed
- · Entries can be oil, water colors, acrylics, and other media that includes painting only
- · Possible Classes may be: Animals, People, Landscape, Still Life; Flora/Plant, etc.

Photography Division

- · Maximum Entries: Six entries per participant
- · Entries must be mounted, matted or framed
- · Photos no smaller than 4x6 and no larger than 8x10.
- · Entries may be colored and black and white photos (digital photos or film photos)
- · Photos MUST be put in one of the following classes:

Animals- Both Domestic and Wildlife Plant/Flora

People Food

Nature/Landscape Catch- ALL
